





Handy said Chamber member Carmen Licari heard about a used clock and went to investigate. Finding it in good shape — and less than one-tenth of the price of clock the Village had tried to buy previously; Carmen purchased it and brought it to the Village DPW garage.

"Under William Viccarelli, the men set to work getting it ready to be installed on Main Street," said Handy.

Bob Borst sanded and primed the clock, preparing it for a new coat of paint, while Jacque Carter and others

prepared the site. Tony Susi arranged for the electricity needed, and the Village crew erected the clock across from the American Legion.

Licari, who notes that a survey shows approximately 8,000 vehicles pass by the corner each day, says the clock came off of the streets of Utica. "The clock is a nice addition to the Main Street," stated Licari. "The Chamber of Commerce is the organization that sponsored the whole project in an effort to beautify Main Street. They deserve all of the credit." Licari also credited the DPW. "They did a lot of work!"

Handy also credits the OESJ school tech class for their handiwork in the corner project.

"We continue to receive compliments on how the clock is a nice addition to the beautiful setting on the corner," Handy stated. "The high school Tech class built the benches under the direction of Kristy Shafer. Ag teacher, Chris Smith, helped and students set the planters and benches up. They filled the planters with compost and planted the flowers."

Handy said the students framed the information booth on the corner and community members helped to finish the project. "I call them the elves of St. Johnsville!" Handy said.

#### Superman in the trunk

Well, not exactly. The incredible power was actually under the hood of Allen Kitts' 1964 Ford Fairlane Thunderbolt. At a recent reunion attended by 35 of the original 100 drivers, a 1/8 scale replica of the cars they had driven was presented to each of them by Albert Ford, grandson of Edsel Ford who ran the company from 1919 to 1943. The names of the drivers were scribed on the doors and a special Superman shield, attesting to Kitts' many victories, was installed in the trunk of his car. According to Kitts, an even greater honor at the end of the ceremony was getting to mesh hands with Albert the great grandson of Henry Ford.

Ironically, and obviously not held against him by Ford, Kitts is now the service manager of Frank Farmer Chevrolet in Metropolis, IL and has been employed by General Motors for more than 35 years. Since his drag racing days Kitts' automotive skills have resulted in his involvement with racing teams and with cars in movies such as Gumball Rally with Gary Busey, Six Pack with Kenny Rogers, In Country with Bruce Willis and on television with The Dukes Of hazard.




Seven bands highlighted the 2015 Music on Mainstreet in Canajoharie, with "tribute bands" proving to bring in the largest crowds.

## When tree roots surface

Much to the dismay of homeowners, landscape trees sometimes grow roots on top of the surface of the lawn or possibly even buckle sidewalks and driveways. These surface roots can be quite a nuisance to lawn mowers and human feet.

There are several reasons why the roots come to the surface. Some tree species are more prone to surface roots than oth-

ers, most notably silver maple, poplar and willow. But almost any large, older tree can produce some surface roots.

Although trees do send some roots down deep for moisture and stability, most tree roots tend to grow much more shallowly than most people think – usually only 4-8-inches deep. Just as the trunk of the tree grows in girth with age, so do the roots.

So over time, some of the shallow, older roots of the tree will naturally enlarge to the surface. Sometimes, roots become visible due to erosion of the surface soil. Compacted, poorly drained soil will also lead to more shallow root development.

Pruning off the visible roots is likely to cause serious damage to the tree over time and should only

be used as a last resort to spare sidewalks and driveways where relocating the pavement is not feasible.

The best prevention for surface roots is to select appropriate plants for the situation such as shorter tree species and planting at least 4-feet away from paved areas. But you already have older

large tree with surfacing roots, you can adapt your landscaping maintenance to help avoid troubles.

A temporary solution to surface roots is to apply a shallow, 1-2-inch layer of good quality soil mix and then replant the grass. However, it won't be long before tree roots will reappear as they continue to grow in girth.

A more permanent so-

lution would be to replant the affected surface area with a taller ground cover type plant that will not need mowing, being careful to avoid injury to the major tree roots at planting. Or, better yet, replace the turf with organic mulch such as shredded or chipped hardwood bark.

Root barriers made of metal, plastic or fabric

have been tried with some degree of success in slowing the development of surface roots. However, over time, most root barriers will fail, either through cracking of the material or roots growing under or over the barrier into decorative top mulch.

Mix 25 drops of catnip essential oil, 1 tsp. real vanilla extract and 4 oz. of rubbing alcohol together in a small spray bottle, and shake well before using. Be careful not to spray into eyes.

# BBB reminder: be smart when shopping for back to school items

It seems back to school season is starting earlier this year. Retailers in Upstate New York are already displaying pens, pencils, electronics and backpacks! Better Business Bureau serving Upstate New York wants to remind those shopping for back to school to be savvy during this, the second busiest shopping time of year.

**Ask about returns and refunds.** Shopping for new clothes, accessories and gadgets is one of the highlights of going back to school. When you buy your new gear, ask about the in-store and online return policy and always keep your receipts.

Find out the details about your new data plan. When it comes to cell phones and other devices, you don't want to sign up for something that you didn't want. Always check the fine print. Ask about the time commitment, billing details, replacement costs and how you can get out of the contract if you need to. It's time consuming but reading your contract carefully can really help you in the long run.

Read the fine print when getting a credit card. Credit cards can be very useful and people get offers for new cards all the time. ## Whatchamacallits

In October, 1875, Ferdinand W. Roebling filed for a U.S. Patent for his improvement on wire rope.


Wire rope is usually composed of a central strand (core) that is surrounded by a number of other strands — usually six.

These outer strands can be different sizes and they may contain any number of wires, usually between seven and 19.


The central strand can be made of iron or steel, even softer material like hemp

was used. With that as a preface, this week's Whatchamacallit is a tool used to possibly measure the gauge of wire rope used with elevator pully mechanisms.

Ferdinand's father, John A. Roebling was responsible for creating the suspension wire that made the Brookyn Bridge, the Golden Gate Bridge and many other suspension bridges possible. His improvements on wire rope created a product that wouldn't snag, kink or twist easily.

well attended."

"Along with our other great acts we will be having the Magic of Jim Snack," reported Bordieri. "This will be our first magic show and will be billed as 'Music on Mainstreet presents Magic on Mainstreet'. Also, our big event will be a re-enactment of The Last Waltz. This will incorporate the use of local talented musicians playing the parts of the guest stars in the movie/concert"

Bordieri said there may be some other changes in the works for the program. "But I am not at liberty to discuss them at this point."





It is mentions that Clark "kept an uplifting spirit, while continuing to serve his community", even after losing most of his prized possessions in a devastating fire, in which he lost his entire home.

"Pat has given back to his community in so many ways throughout his life, setting a positive example and sharing his time, knowledge and experience; we owe him our thanks for the encouragement, acceptance, assistance, and services that he provides to our community."

"It's an honor to think that people think that well of me in this manner," says Clark. "That they think this well of me—that is what stands out to me."





#### AC or windows down: secrets to better summer fuel economy

(BPT) — Summer is dows depends on driving peak travel season for most Americans. Those hoping to spend less on fuel and more on fun can find ways to stretch their travel budgets with better vehicle care and use.

One hotly (pun intended) debated topic during summer driving season is whether it is more fuel efficient to use the air conditioner (AC) or roll down the windows and catch the breeze to stay cool.

To settle the AC versus windows question, researchers at Oak Ridge National Laboratory in Tennessee compared the performance of a Ford Explorer and a Toyota Corolla. It's probably no surprise that fuel consumption was the lowest when AC was off and the windows were up. But that's not a great option on a 95-degree day.

When driving at speeds slower than 75 mph, researchers found it was more efficient to roll down the windows. At speeds faster than 75 mph, it was more efficient to run the AC in the Corolla, but not the Explorer, likely because the larger cabin was harder to cool.

Edmunds.com experts found similar results with a Toyota Tundra, which got almost 10 percent better gas mileage at 65 mph with the windows down and AC off. In Consumer Reports tests with a Honda Accord, using air conditioning while driving at 65 mph reduced gas mileage by more than 3 mpg, while the effect of opening the windows at 65 mph was not measurable.

So deciding whether to choose AC or open winspeed, wind speed, terrain, vehicle size and aerodynamics. Thankfully, other ways to improve fuel efficiency are less complicated.

Good vehicle maintenance is the best way to improve fuel economy, says Andrew Hamilton, technical services and manager quality

Cenex brand lubricants. "To maintain your vehicle's top fuel efficiency, perform regular maintenance, including oil changes and replacing the air filter and spark plugs," says Hamilton.

Use the manufacturer recommended engine oil to get the most from your enviscosity can reduce fuel efficiency by five to ten percent," says Hamilton.

Finally, don't forget tire care. The U.S. Department of Energy reports that 1.25 billion gallons of gas are wasted every year by driving on underinflated tires. "Properly inflated tires last longer, reduce braking distance and improve fuel efficiency," says Hamilton. The inflation guidelines can be found in the vehicle's owner's manual or on the driver's side door.


