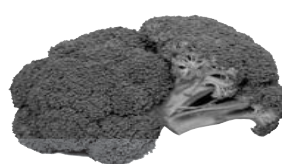

## THE TRUTH OF THE MATTER:

The Town of Palatine is NOT broke-- we are actually in a good place financially. Even subtracting the \$400,000+ that is in the Committed Fund for a new Town Hall, we have a "comfortable" fund balance.

The "proposed" Town Hall Project is not estimated at over \$500,000-- the first attempt to receive and accept bids, brought the project total up to approximately \$416,000- and with the \$30,000 Office of Court Administration Grant- we were in a good place within the total available for the building. Unfortunately, the numerous lawsuits and other unfortunate "circumstances" halting the project have cost the town unnecessary expenses. Also, the stalling of the project may very well cause the loss of the \$30,000 Grant.

The present Council members do not have any ulterior motives. We are all taxpayers, just like you, and want to keep the tax rate down and still provide the essential services that have been provided in the past. We want to work with the residents of the Town of Palatine to move forward and maintain a manageable tax rate for all. It is also our goal to work TOGETHER and respect the ideas and decisions we each may have- not always agreeing, but respecting that all of us have different outlooks. We all want to make decisions that are the best for those who elect us, putting our own opinions aside to do what really is the right thing for our town.

Honestly, we do want progress in this little place we all call home. It is essential to move forward with bringing business in to the town, as well as new residents. A town-wide Revaluation of property is needed to bring us to 100% valuation. The Comprehensive Plan must be updated to bring it up to present-day circumstances and needs.

## Whatchamacallits

This Whatchamacallit is easily identified as a saddlebag, with lock affixed. Presumably, this saddlebag dates back to the late 1800s, after the creation of the Pony Express.

A mailbag is a generic term for a type of bag used for collecting, carrying, categorizing and classifying different types of postal material.

It has several names: mail sack, mail satchel, mail pouch, catcher pouch, mochila, or portmanteau.

Pony Express riders traveled about 100 miles at any one time.

Saddlebag mail pouches were never in use on the Pony Express system because of their unwieldiness. The normal large saddle bags were not adept to attaching

to a saddle efficiently and would cause much delay when going from an exhausted horse to a fresh horse when the Pony Express rider switched horses at a station. In 1860 the Pony Express developed a fast mail delivery system using a special saddle mailbag cover called a mochila that made the Pony Express unique.

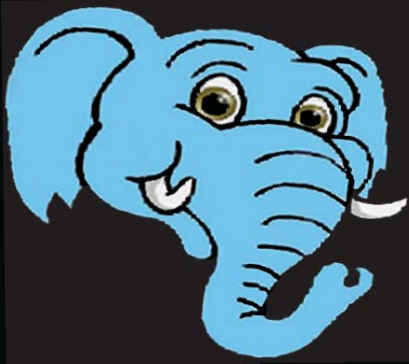
