





THREAT OF 34% TAX HIKE STOPPED

The concerned residents of Saint Johnsville turned out in record numbers on Thursday night at a public hearing to voice their opposition to the proposed property tax hike of 34% that was included in the current town board's 2016 proposed budget.

It was standing room only when some 250 residents filed into the garage portion of the town barn. The large number surprised the current town board members. Included in this budget was a proposed property re-evaluation, and an 86% increase in the highway department's budget.

The current board estimated the re-evaluation to be \$130,000 which would be borrowed from a bank to be repaid in five (5) equal payments of \$30,000 each, which includes the interest on the loan. Most of the property owners who asked the board questions about this re-evaluation wanted to understand exactly how this re-evaluation would be conducted, when it would be done, if qualified people would be re-assessing their properties, and exactly how a re-evaluation would impact each resident.

The present administration could not answer these important questions by the property owners. Not one of their questions were answered. Many of the property owners recommended to the board to table this for now until an expert could come to Saint Johnsville, meet with the property owners, and explain to them all of their concerns BEFORE a re-evaluation would be considered.

This forced the current town board to reconsider the proposed tax hike and reduce the proposed 2016 budget. The General Fund was reduced from \$345,603 to \$183,603. Most of the \$162,000 taken from the General Fund was due to removing the proposed re-evaluation and animal control expenses.

"This is what can happen when the residents band together and voice their concerns about their town. The town board is in charge of managing THEIR tax dollars. If these property owners had not been at the public hearing on this proposed 34% tax increase, then the proposed 2016 budget would have been passed. We must all accept the challenge of actively participating in our local government. The town board must be accountable to us...the tax payers," said Martha Mancini, local resident. "I would like to thank each and every person that attended this public hearing. I really appreciate each of you answering the call of duty," she added.
