### Rabies vaccination clinics for March

Saturday, March 12, Mohawk Town Barn, 2-4 Park St., Fonda, 9 a.m. to noon.



New York State Public Health Law requires that all dogs, cats and domestic ferrets shall have initial vaccinations administered against rabies no later than four months of age and stay up to date with re-vaccinations. Re-vaccinations are required one year later and a booster shot every three years. It is important to have pets vaccinated in a timely manner in order for the pet to be considered protected against the virus. Pet owners should bring proof of their pet's last rabies vaccination. This helps the veterinarian determine whether the pet will receive a one or three year vac-

cination, without it your pet will receive a one-year vaccination only.

Veterinarian administration fee is \$10 per rabies vaccine. Other vaccines will be available at an additional fee.

To assure the safety of other pets and people, dogs must be leashed, cats and ferrets must be contained in a pet carrier or box when attending the rabies clinic.

### New York State DMV warns of ID theft risk from posting driver license images to social media

With proliferation of social media and information sharing, people put themselves at risk of fraud and financial problems showing off new permits and driver licenses

The New York State Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) warned drivers of the risk of identity theft from posting images of their newly-obtained permits and driver licenses on social media, particularly popular among young adults. The sensitive information on DMV identification documents, including a driver address, date of birth, and signature, make it easy for any social media user to steal a victim's identity. This, in turn, can result in a lifetime of compromised credit and financial ruin.

"Passing a driver's test is a very exciting time in a young person's life and DMV understands why teens are excited to show off their permits and licenses," said DMV Executive Deputy Commissioner Terri Egan. "Just don't make your personal information public in the process. Having your identity stolen and your privacy compromised is not a good way to celebrate getting your driver

About six percent of identity theft victims are 19 years old and younger, according to the Federal Trade Commission (FTC), but posting photos of IDs on social media is just one way teens and young adults can get into financial trouble down the road. In August, Governor Cuomo issued a (DFI) will acknowledge rewarning to college students that purchasing fake IDs and false identification documents increases the chances of becoming a victim of identity fraud.

According to the Identity Theft Resource Center, a non-profit organization founded to provide victim assistance and consumer education, victims whose identity is compromised from driver license information most often discover trouble when they find unexplained traffic violations appearing on their driving records. Identity theft topped the FTC's national ranking of consumer complaints for the 15th consecutive year in

Motorists who have evidence that another person has a driver license, registration document, or title certificate in their name, or evidence that another person used their identity and DMV ID number for fraudulent purposes, should request a Report for Unauthorized Use form (FI-17) from a DMV Call Center or a DMV office. Evidence can include traffic tickets, forged personal checks or documents that contain the DMV ID number from the motorist's driver license, learner permit, or nondriver ID. DMV's Division of Field Investigation

ceipt of the report and determine if there has been any license activity under the motorist's name in New York State

If you believe that your identity has been stolen or your private information compromised, DFI suggests that you do the following:

- File a report with the local law enforcement agency.
- Notify your bank, your financial institutions, creditors, and each

of the three major credit bureaus that your identification documents have been lost or stolen.

- Periodically obtain and review a copy of your credit report.
- Be alert for indications that someone may

be using your identity, such as receiving mailings from government agencies (such as DMV suspension notices) or suspicious contacts (phone calls from retail outlets granting "instant

### Me? A catskinner?

My husband, Sam, was still trying to finish up a big septic job in Connecticut so he could move to

Esperance, NY, for good and do some serious farming. We had our first herd of pigs to attend to, which left me with the chore of feeding them twice a day.

Before we found a local vegetable farmer who was willing to donate unsalable produce as supplemental feed, I had to cut tall grass every day. With long clippers, I built up a few arm muscles producing something for them to supplement the daily hog feed. Since Sam was not able to be here to rototill the gardens, the grasses took over the vegetables.

Luckily for the pigs I cut a great deal of lambs' quarters, which eventually developed into even more nutritious quinoa. There were also alfalfa, clover and what looked like Kentucky Blue Grass.

With a riding mower Sam had acquired in trade for three bales of hay, a small trailer in tow, I transported armloads of my cuttings to the greedy, rowdy porkers.

When I started picking up great tubs full of recycled produce, I would back our pick up truck to the fence and laboriously heave one veggie at a time to the hungry animals. Often, I would pitch, baseball style, zucchini, tomatoes, plums, peaches, onions, celery and various squashes. And later, pumpkins, which had to be chopped before I could even pick them up. When Sam visited the farm on weekends, he would load his Hitachi excavator with veggies and feed the pigs their supplement in just one stroke.

When Photographer Charles Clements first saw Benjamin Holt's huge steam tractor with its undulating tracks Bud, the catskinner
worming its way through

a field of barley in 1904,

he called the newly-in-

vented contraption a

"Caterpillar."

The logical moniker for the strong, agile, hardy men who operated these machines became "Catskinner." Today, any expert operator of any heavy equipment is considered a catskinner.

My husband is a bona fide catskinner. I am not. "You can do it," he promised.

I climbed into the cab and allowed him to show me the simple controls of the big machine. So, now, at age 84, I climb into the back of the pickup truck, heave produce into the Hitachi bucket, then maneuver the big machine over to the fence and, gently, slowly, dump a load of veggies into the herd. The hogs will try to climb into the bucket.

Only a few shin shears and black and blue knees resulted from climbing in and off the Hitachi.

Bud, our black Lab, is scared to death of the sounds of skeet shooting that goes on every Sunday next door. One day the fearful dog gave me an anxious look and leaped into the cab of the Hitachi with me, crowding me out. Bud's no catskinner either but he certainly knows how to board the machine in a hurry. I managed to exit the machine with some effort with the big dog squeezing me, ran for my camera and snapped the

### Did you know?


### How to maintain mental focus

In a 2013 analysis of 19 studies involving more than 500 children, teenagers and young adults, and researchers found that exercise sessions between 10 and 40 minutes immediately boosted concentration and mental focus. That improvement might be a result of exercise increasing blood flow to the brain. Men and women who find themselves struggling to focus at work after

lunchtime may benefit from incorporating some exercise, whether it's a brief walk or a more strenuous workout, into their midday routines.

- Perform breathing exercises. Nervousness is an oft-overlooked cause of loss of focus. When nervous, breath can become shallow and restricted, which can have a negative impact on the flow of oxygen to your brain, making it more difficult to concentrate. Professional athletes have long espoused to the virtues of breathing exercises as a means to calming their nerves, and professionals can follow suit. Some simple breathing exercises can help busy professionals multitask more effectively by helping them concentrate on the tasks at hand and overcome the distraction of having so much to do at one time.
- Stay hydrated. A recent study published in the Journal of Nutrition found that dehydration caused loss of focus and a sense of fatigue among women. While the loss of focus was considered insubstantial

and the study only examined women, remaining hydrated throughout the day may make it easier to focus on work and other tasks throughout the day.

· Get adequate sleep. One of the best ways to improve focus during the day is to make sure you're getting enough sleep at night. Sleep deprivation produces a host of negative consequences, not the least of which is its impact on cognitive functioning. Research has shown that sleep deprivation compromises alertness and concentration, making it more difficult to focus at work and tackle tasks that require deep analysis and thought. In addition, a survey from the National Sleep Foundation found that sleep-deprived men and women are less likely to exercise and eat healthy diets, each of which can boost mental acuity.

Focusing in today's atmosphere of constant distractions can be difficult, but men and women can overcome diversions by employing a handful of successful strategies aimed at improving concentration.



### Did you know?

The Celtic cross is a symbol widely associated with Ireland, but many may not know the unique history and debate surrounding this unique and instantly recognizable symbol. The Celtic cross combines a cross with a circle surrounding its intersection, but other than that description, little can be confirmed about the origins of this symbol that some historians believe can be traced back to ancient paganism.

Historical revisionist author and researcher Crichton E.M. Miller theorizes that the cross had more practical purposes than those subscribed to it today, serving as a navigational device used by ancient explorers and builders.


One popular, though highly unlikely, theory regarding the origins of the Celtic cross is that it was introduced by St. Patrick, Ireland's patron saint. This theory states that St. Patrick, or possibly St. Declan, combined the cross, which is the foremost symbol of Christianity, with the sun cross, a circular symbol traced to prehistoric cultures, in an attempt to illustrate

the importance of the cross to the pagans he was attempting to convert.

Though the exact origins of the Celtic cross

and its meaning will likely never be known, there is no denying its endurance as a symbol and its ongoing association with Ireland.







### Whatchamacallits -



Hunters and sportsmen through the years have reloaded their own ammunition to reduce the cost of their sport. It is still done today. This weeks' Whatchamacallit is a pair of reloading tools.

The odd looking one on the left, pictured with *Cartridge Reloading Tools of the Past*, is the Winchester Model 1891 Reloading Tool manufactured by the Winchester Repeating Arms Co. of New Haven, CT. It was patented on March 17, 1891,



is made of polished, blued steel and is marked for 38-55 caliber. The sportsman was able with one tool to decap the case, seat the primer and force the assembled case into

a die by rotating the handles to complete the reloading process. Although remarkable in its application, this model was short-lived as it was complicated in its design and slow and awkward in its operation.

The other item is a Winchester bullet mold marked for 38-56 caliber WCF (Winchester Center Fire), so they could have been used in conjunction with each other.

# Pruning fruit trees and other March gardening tips

Pruning fruit trees, sowing seeds, and starting begonia tubers are some of the gardening activities for this month.

Choose a day above freezing, if possible, to prune fruit trees as it is easier on you as well as on the tree. First, check for and remove the 3 D's—branches that are dead (usually a different color), diseased (look for scabs or spots), and damaged (as from ice damage or wind breakage).

Then, check for and remove the 2 C's — branches that are crowded or crossing (they'll rub on each other, wearing off the bark where disease can enter). Finally, prune selectively, shaping the tree according to its age and type of fruit tree.

By starting your own plants from seeds, you'll save money and be able to grow unusual varieties not readily available in nurseries. Start seeds in flats filled with moistened seed-starting mix. Once the seeds germinate, place the plants under tube lights or grow lights (14 hours a day, 6 to 8 inches above seedlings), and keep soil moist.

Organize seed packets by planting time. Some seeds are generally sown directly in the garden so should be set aside into one group. These include ones such as corn, beans, and carrots. A few flowers are often sown directly into the soil, including sweet peas and nasturtium. I like to sow most of my seeds, even ones such as squash that can be sown directly, into peat pots or cell packs prior, to get a slight jump

on our usually short growing season.

Group seeds to be started indoors, and then arrange them by planting time. For example, start with seeds that should be planted indoors 8 weeks before the average last frost, followed by those to be planted 6 weeks before, and so on. If you haven't tracked, or aren't sure of, your average last frost date, figure on perhaps mid-May in USDA zone 5, late May in zone 4, and early June or later in zone 3. This date of course varies with your own specific climate and

Some of the flowers you may want to start this month, about 8 weeks before planting out, include ageratum, coleus, dianthus, geranium, impatiens, ornamental millet, petunia, salvia, and annual vinca. To get a jump

on the herb gardening season, start seeds of basil, parsley, sage, and thyme indoors. Start seeds of cole crops, including broccoli, cabbage, Brussels sprouts, and cauliflower. You'll have transplant-sized plants of these in about 6 weeks, ready for planting outdoors a few weeks before the average last spring frost date (since they tolerate some cold).

Wait until next month to start most vegetables. If you sow tomatoes too early, you'll end up with spindly and leggy plants. Aim for about 6 weeks prior to planting outside for these (after the last usual frost date). More details on sowing dates can be found in catalogs and online.

Plant begonia tubers in containers to get an early start. Plant them hollowside-up in well-drained potting soil. Set them in a warm (70 degrees F) location and keep the soil moist but not soggy. Once you see growth — usually in 3 or 4 weeks — place the pots in bright, indirect light. Wait to plant outdoors until all

danger of frost is past.

Other gardening activities for this month include watching for and attending flower and garden seminars, visiting a maple sugarhouse, and removing heavy winter mulch from perennials.

### A new car vs. your used car: What's the greener option?

(BPT) — Buying a new car to reduce your carbon footprint seems logical. But surprisingly, keeping the vehicle already in your garage, or replacing it with a more fuel efficient used car may be a greener choice. That's because it takes a lot of energy and raw materials to manufacture a new vehicle. "It varies between models, but it is reasonable to estimate building a new \$30,000 midsize

car will generate greenhouse gases that are the equivalent of 14 metric tons of CO<sup>2</sup>," says Rock-Auto.com Vice President, Tom Taylor.

The average car on the road is about 11 years old. EPA data shows that vehicles (cars and trucks) built in 2005, on average, emit 447 grams of CO<sup>2</sup> per mile. A 2016 vehicle is expected to generate about 90 grams less than that every mile. Produc-

ing less CO<sup>2</sup> is good, but it would take more than 150,000 miles of driving for that 90 grams in CO<sup>2</sup> savings to add up and compensate for the 14,000 kg (14 metric tons of CO2) it took to build the new car. Especially for someone who does not drive a lot, it could be greener to just keep a well-maintained older vehicle than to build a new

### How much do you save with an electric car?

Electric cars do not have tailpipes, but an electric car is still on the hook for "upstream CO2" emitted by the utility that provides the electricity for the car. The EPA estimates upstream CO2 is around 100 grams per mile for most electric vehicles. That is a whopping 347 grams less than what is produced by the average vehicle built in 2005, but it would still take over 40,000 miles of

driving before the electric car saved enough CO<sup>2</sup> to cover the greenhouse gas cost of building it in the first place.


### The environmental cost of servicing older cars

What about the CO<sup>2</sup> equivalent discharged while making parts to fix an older car? Brake pads, struts, tires and other

parts wear out as the miles pile up. Fortunately, unless the vehicle is involved in an accident, the structure that makes up most of a car will never need to be replaced.

Many smaller parts like alternators and major parts like engines and transmissions can be remanufactured. Remanufacturing means only the components that experience wear are replaced. Metal housings and other major pieces can be cleaned, refinished and reused. "Remanufacturing saves more than 80 percent of the energy and raw materials required to build a new part from scratch," Taylor says. Less energy and materials means less CO<sup>2</sup>.

Car manufacturers are using more recycled materials and updating factories to use less energy. Government mandates require future vehicles become increasingly more fuel-efficient. "Upstream CO2" may decline as utility companies find new, greener ways to generate electricity. Nevertheless, keeping your current car well maintained or buying a more fuel-efficient used car are currently great choices if you want to be

# Tips for preowned vehicle buyers

The impression of used cars and trucks has changed dramatically in recent years. Now widely referred to as "preowned vehicles," such automobiles are now the first choice of many buyers who want reliable vehicles without having to pay full sticker price.

While buying preowned vehicles is less risky to-day than it might have been two decades ago, there is still some risk for buyers who purchase cars that are not brand new. The following tips can help motorists find preowned vehicles that suit their needs and budgets.

• Do your homework. Drivers rarely buy brand new vehicles without first researching the makes and models they are considering. Whether they are checking a vehicle's ratings, safetv gas mileage or warranty terms, buyers know that such research is essential to making the most informed decisions. Resources such as Kelley Blue Book (www.kbb.com) and the Edmunds.com True Market Value (TMV)® pricing tool can help buyers make the best buying decisions. Using such resources is quick and easy and can help buyers quell any concerns they might have about overpaying for preowned cars or trucks.

• Insist on a pre-purchase inspection for vehicles not designated as



certified preowned vehicles. Before making an offer on a preowned vehicle, buyers should insist on a pre-purchase inspection performed by their own mechanics. Such inspections are not necessary when buying certified preowned vehicles from dealerships because such certifications are only granted when manufacturers or other certifying authorities have inspect-

ed the vehicles before they were offered for sale. If private sellers or dealers selling uncertified preowned vehicles resist your efforts to get a prepurchase inspection, walk away and continue your search elsewhere.

Preowned vehicles no longer carry the stigma they once did, and savvy buyers can find great deals on reliable preowned automobiles.

### How to sell a vehicle with an accident history

Selling a vehicle may seem easy, but unloading preowned vehicles may take some time. While sellers may already have their eyes on the prize—a new vehicle—the first step is selling their current vehicle at a fair price, especially for those sellers who need to finance the purchase of

their next vehicle with the proceeds they earn when selling their current one.

Sellers must consider a host of factors, including potential market for the vehicle and its potential sale price, before putting their vehicles up for sale. The accident history of a vehicle is another important factor to consider. Buyers are understandably weary about purchasing vehicles that have been in an accident. Easily accessible vehicle history reports can make it even more challenging to sell a used car, but such reports don't make it impossible to unload preowned vehicles.

• Be open and honest. Hiding an accident is unethical and can haunt you down the road. It is better to be forthcoming about any accidents a vehicle might have been in. If you have documentation of the accident, such

as photos and receipts for repairs, make it available to prospective buyers. If you have certification from an auto body shop or mechanic that the vehicle is in perfectly good condition and was repaired with quality, manufacturer-supplied parts, offer that information as well. The more information you provide and the more honest and forthcoming you are, the less it will seem like you're trying to hide major dam-

- Encourage a vehicle inspection. Inform the buyer that you have no qualms about him or her taking the car to a mechanic and having it thoroughly inspected. This will show your confidence in the performance of the vehicle.
- Consider a dealer trade-in. Dealer trade-ins may not earn you as much money than you

would get if you were to sell the car privately, but trade-ins tend to be simpler. Dealerships have almost zero emotional attachment to vehicles and likely won't be as concerned as a private buyer about an accident on record. Some dealers farm out used cars to auctions or salvage yards. It may be worth it to take the lower price and not have headache of unloading the car on your own.

• Be flexible on pricing. The right price will help prospective buyers overlook minor blemishes or accidents. When coupled with the truth, the right price can entice buyers to seal the deal.

Auto accidents happen. But while no one wants to get into a fender-bender, such accidents should not prevent auto owners from selling their vehicles in the future.




