Remembering Hagbard

Several years ago, Anne Hornacek, a lifelong native and former owner of the Park Inn in Richfield Springs, showed me a painting that she bought from my Aunt Ruta who was selling her house and going to live with a relative in Detroit. It was a rough portrait of a man wearing a stylish widebrimmed hat. "I bought it because the man looks like my late father," Anne

"That's Hagbard," I said.

"Who?" Anne asked surprised.

"Hagbard Ekerold. He and his wife were good friends of my Aunt Ruta and Uncle William."

"You're putting me on, Anne said."

"No," I insisted. "I knew them."

We looked at the por-

closely. enough a pale inscription was in the lower right hand corner. It spelled out Hagbard. He was a giant of a man, a Scandinavian who stood about six feet five. His wife Helen used to paint. She was most likely the one who had done the portrait. She was also an actress and used to perform at Duke's Oak on the west side of Otsego Lake. They were an odd pair, always dressing in clothing that looked more like costumes than clothes appropriate to care for the geese, ducks, goats and other animals they had on their place which was situated high on County Route 16 overlooking the

Donnelly farm. Jim Don-

nelly recalled that, "Of-

ten the ducks and geese

would wander down to

our place. The Ekerolds

would come after them but eventually some of their flock stayed with us."

When Hagbard was looking for a second hand car Aunt Ruta was instrumental in helping him find a faded maroon 1949 Chevrolet convertible. It wasn't the most practical car, especially in the winter. In warmer weather, when the Scandinavian would take it for a ride, he'd wear driving goggles, I guess because his head topped the windshield. Pulling out of the driveway of my aunt's house on Lake Street with the top down one afternoon, they made quite a crew, Hagbard with his goggles, Aunt Ruta riding shotgun with her cane propped in front of her chin, Uncle William puffing on his pipe so that





tion up there. I was impressed but a bit skeptical and said, "Eskimos don't have radios."

"It was a strategic installation," Hagbard explained. "For government and scientific use."

I guess finding out that there was actually a real person behind the portrait made it more difficult for Anne Hornacek to imagine that it was a likeness of her father. Maybe I shouldn't have said anything because not long after I identified the man in the sketch she gave it to me and I have it hanging on the wall at our camp. 



Whatchamacallits

A couple of weeks ago, we featured the compact travel candlestick. This week's Whatchamacallit (or similar items) would have been in a travelers' pack as well from 1800 - 1884.

Our pair of objects is an ink dip pen (or nib pen) with carrying case and portable ink well.

Prior to the development and use of the metal nib, quill pens were the writing implements of choice — usually made from a molted feather from a large bird.

Dip pens have no built-in reservoir, so the user had to continually recharge the pen using a bowl (or well) or bottle.

The metal tipped dip pen consists of a metal nib with capillary channels mounted on a handle or holder made wood and other materials. Common handles at the time included bone and ivory — more extravagant handles would have been



made of precious metals and highly


It gained widespread use after 1830 and by 1850, quill pen usage faded as the quality of steel nibs improved.

The proper fountain pen was invented in 1884 and our modern ballpoint version was invented in 1938. By 1945, the ballpoint pen was introduced to the U.S. market.

Dip pens are still in use today,



mainly by illustrators, calligraphers and comic artists due to their sensitivity to varying pressure and speed.

How to cut the cost of auto insurance

The cost of auto insurance is contingent on a host of variables. Such factors include the type of vehicle being insured and the driving record of the policyholder.

While drivers may feel they have little leeway regarding the cost of their auto insurance, there are several steps motorists of all ages can take to lower their auto insurance premiums.

• Address your credit score. Policyholders' credit histories are one of the factors insurance companies use when determining the cost of individuals' insurance policies. Before shopping for new policies, drivers should take steps to improve their credit scores by paying off their consumer debts and having any discrepancies on their credit reports corrected.

• Continue your education as a motorist. The III notes that non-driving factors, such as age, are among the variables insurance companies consider when determining the cost of their automotive policies. While older drivers can't reverse the aging process and younger drivers can't add years to their driving histories overnight, there are ways these drivers can lessen the impact their ages have on the cost of their auto insurance premiums. Advanced defensive driving courses can refresh older drivers' memories with regards to safe driving techniques while also teaching them the latest techniques to stay safe behind the wheel. Younger drivers who take such courses can be taught how to drive in emergency situations in controlled environments.

Consumer notes that a 2012 report jointly sponsored by the U.S. government, AAA Foundation for Traffic Safety and Manitoba Public Insurance found that there is no evidence that traditional driver's education classes reduce crashes, highlighting the importance of advanced courses that can prepare older and younger drivers alike for what awaits them on the open road. Taking such classes can save drivers as much as 10 percent on their auto insurance premiums, and those discounts may even last several years.

- Adjust your existing policy. Mileage is another factor insurance companies use when pricing their automotive policies. While driving habits change, few drivers think to contact their insurance companies when their habits change in ways that can save them money. If your daily commute is shorter than it was when you initially opened your policy or if you now take public transportation to save money on gas, contact your insurance agent and give a more upto-date assessment of your driving habits. Doing so might save you a considerable amount of money each year.
- Combine your policies. Perhaps the simplest way to save on auto insurance is to combine your auto and home insurance policies. Covering your vehicles and your home via the same provider may save you as much as 15 percent on each policy.

Auto insurance is a considerable expense, but drivers can take numerous steps to reduce the costs of their policies.




