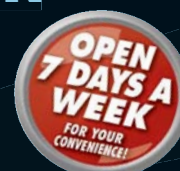

Fort Plain celebrates Memorial Day with traditions

Fort Plain began Memorial Day with the traditional gathering of veterans at the bridge and throwing of a wreath into the Mohawk River in remembrance of deceased sailors.

According to Past Commander Brad Schrell, who led the Memorial service, the tradition of throwing the wreath into the river has been ongoing for over 35 years.

Navy veteran Barry Yeardon said the tradition first began after Pearl Harbor to honor fallen Navy and Marines. The tradition became more widespread during the 1950s and 1960s with the Korean and Vietnam Wars and the many battles in the Pacific where so many lives were lost. The American Legion led the tradition.

After the American Legion Color Guard disbanded, the Veterans of Foreign Wars' (VFW) Memorial Squad picked up the tradition and it spread even further across the USA.

The Fort Plain American Legion Post 554 brought the tradition to Fort Plain, where it was started by Army Veteran Paul Roberts and Navy Veteran Roger J. Bower and is carried on today by the VFW Color Guard and Memorial Squad.

Also traditional is the dedication of the flag to a deceased veteran. And following the ceremony of the

wreath thrown into the river, veterans moved to the VFW to dedicate a flag to Joseph Rebello. This flag will be flown for one year, until next Memorial Day, when another flag will be dedicated.

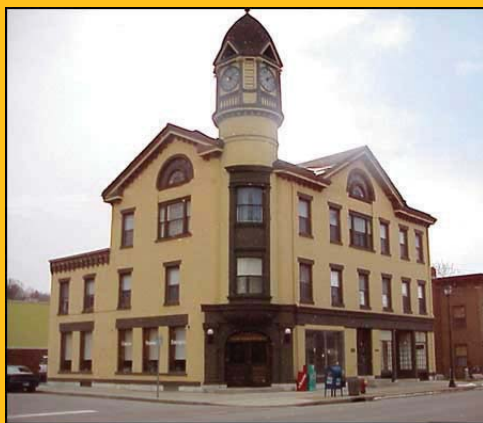

Whatchamacallits



You may guess this week's grouping of Whatchamacallits pretty quickly. They all perform the same task, although they were made in different eras and are used on different sized blades.

That is correct—they are blade sharpeners. Three of them have the spinning disc approach and one has an abrasive stone insert.

Two of the designs incorporate a clamp for easy use with free hands—possibly for larger tool blades as opposed to cutlery. The smaller one is very similar to many examples that were found online and is of a design still in widely used today.

I tried to find information about the manufacturer of the one with the wooden handle (H. Brocket of No. Haven, CT), but to no avail; its sharpening discs are opposing, textured and conical.

Today as I was chatting with two women friends, the topic turned to rhubarb — such a wonderful harbinger of spring.

One woman spoke of pulling a stalk of rhubarb from the garden clump and eating it with a sprinkle of salt. The other woman exclaimed, "I just pulled it and chomped away on it, no salt needed; never minded the sour taste at all."

I shuddered and said what I resent these days is having to pay two or three dollars for a couple of spindly stalks in the grocery store. I grew up with Dad's bounteous rhubarb patch in our back yard, there for the picking. All we'd ever want and more, and Mom canned numerous jars for our enjoyment during the winter.

Mom's rhubarb pie was an eagerly anticipated dessert at family dinners; a flaky crust (made with lard, naturally) covering a filling of juicy rhubarb and sugar, thickened slightly with a bit of flour and a pat of butter — just the best always. And it was usually accompanied with a delicious wedge of really

sharp New England cheese — the perfect finishing touch.

Another choice might be a small side dish of stewed, sweetened rhubarb ("rhubarb sauce") to accompany some juicy pork chops — a taste like no other.

Saturday at the neighborhood Farmer's Market I bought a tiny jar of locally made, low-sugar strawberry-rhubarb jam. It was a tasty little treat, very nice on my breakfast toast, but I do think the same jam I used to make, with real sugar, tasted better. Oh well — we do give up some things as we get older... among them jam making — and real sugar!

A cooking magazine I recently glanced through featured a few new ways to use rhubarb. One was for a chutney or a salsa, again, to go with a pork chop. The other was for a strawberry-rhubarb curd, to be used as a filling in a cake or cookies. Both sound delicious and are a beautiful shade of pinkish red. Maybe tomorrow I'll bite the bullet, pay the price for a half dozen stalks and enjoy something with rhubarb, for old times' sake.

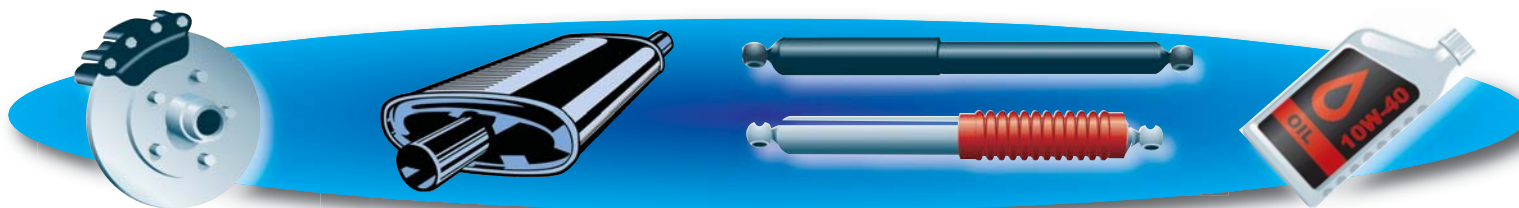
