hatchamacallits

This week's Whatchamacallit garnered a lot of attention as it sat near my desk. Although most folks guessed it was a grinder or mill of some sort, no one guessed it was a paint or pigment mill.

The original mill patent was issued to Oliver C. Harris of Sangerfield, NY on March 15, 1832. Apparently, Mr. Harris made some modification, as our model is forged with the re-issued patent date of August 1848 on the base, and was manufactured in Waterville.

The pigment would be placed in the reservoir and ground by turning the handle. The ground pigments would be pressed out of the sides and scraped by the scraper, causing the pigments to fall into some sort of receptacle. The ground pigment would be gathered and stored for sale.

Paint used to be a luxury item as it was time consuming to grind the pigment by hand (using a mill stone or mortar and pestal) into a powder fine enough to be mixed with the vehicle (liquid base).



the pigment and vehicle were purchased separately and mixed at home by the consumer. It wasn't until 1867 that manufacturers began mixing the liquid base and the pigment for customers.


