Fort Plain Museum holds Aug. 2, 1780 Raid of Canajohary Memorial

The 236th anniversary of a raid on Canajoharie during the Revolutionary War occurred on Aug. 2. This attack on the town was beyond the scope of a simple raid. The English plans were to depopulate the town in order to better retain the area after the war. The raid left many houses and barns burned. One account states that, "At the fort now called fort Ransalaer (Fort Plain), Sir John Johnson and Captain Brant have burnt 51 houses, 42 barns, 17 killed, and 52 prisoners." The local militia was trailing an English supply line and was therefore unable to defend the town. This caused Fort Rensselaer (Fort Plain) to be defended for the most part by women on this fateful day. The women dressed in male overcoats and hats to give the illusion of men manning the fort. This is the Second Annual August 2nd Memorial held at the Fort Plain Museum.

Accounts of the raid were seen in major

newspapers about two weeks after the attack and reached a London newspaper by October, which read, "Accounts of the damage done by the motley allies of Great Britain, up the Mohawk River, are very imperfect. It is reported they have burnt the principal part of Canajohary, a fine settlement about 36 miles from Albany."

Matt Ossenfort, Montgomery County Executive, gave a brief introduction on the memorial and the importance in commemorating the events in the area that ultimately led to our independence as a country. Kassandra Gustin followed by reading the names of those who perished during the raid.

The memorial was accompanied by the Tryon County Militia, which gave a musket salute after a wreath was placed at the base of the Museums' flagpole.

Brian Mack and Norm Bollen helped to make this event possible. This memorial is one of many events put on by the Fort Plain Museum and Historic Park that serve to teach and maintain the importance of local history in the Mohawk Valley.

Parade held to honor the life of Warren Roosevelt

The recent passing of Warren P. Roosevelt Sr., a guiding force at M.W. Roosevelt and Son, Inc. in Canajoharie and Cobleskill, NY since 1954 was marked by a funeral parade procession of tow trucks and towing equipment that started in Canajoharie and went to Johnstown.

In Warren Roosevelt's honor, a Tow Truck Parade commenced on Saturday, July 30, at 9:15 a.m. at M.W. Roosevelt and Son, Inc. on Erie Blvd Canajoharie. The parade continued down Route 5 to the Yost Rest Area, where a ceremonial transfer of Warren's cremated remains between trucks took place. The parade then continued

through Fonda to Route 30A, ending at the Holiday Inn in Johnstown.

The parade featured many dozens of tow trucks — small, big, and medium in size — from all over New York State.

Under Warren's guidance, Roosevelt's was known as a trusted dealership in the area that specialized in sales, service and bodywork. Warren, a former resident of Canada Lake and Fonda, NY passed away in Punta Gorda, FL on July 15, 2016. Born on April 11, 1938 in Amsterdam, NY he was the son of the late Melfred "Jake" and Alberta Engel Roosevelt.

A lifelong area resident, Warren was a 1955 graduate of Fonda-Fultonville

Central School, and served as a member of the National Guard from 1954-1961. In 1954 he joined with his father in the operation of the family business. He was a New York State Certified Heavy Duty Truck Inspector and Automobile Body Appraiser. He was also an adjuster for AETNA Insurance.

In an effort to improve customer service, Warren and his father Jake decided to expand their business to include towing services and purchased their first tow truck (a 1948 bubble nose). Since that time, Roosevelt's has become the longest tenured Towing and Recovery Authorized Garage on the New York State Thruway. Towing became Warren's passion and he was instrumental in promoting the industry. He was considered a legend within the towing community, both locally and internationally. Warren served as a founding member and officer of the Empire State Towing and Recovery Association (ESTRA). He was also one of the original six "Friends of Towing" which founded the International Towing and Recovery Hall of Fame and Museum in Chattanooga, TN; where Warren's restored 1948 bubble nose resides. He served as a five-term director on the Board for The International Towing and Recovery Hall of Fame and Museum and in 1989 was inducted into their Hall of Fame.

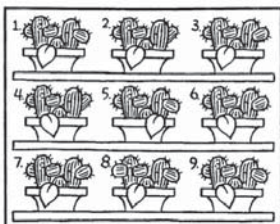

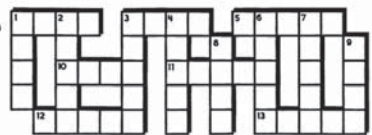

Whatchamacallits



This week's Whatchamacallit is an RPM counter. Some refer to it as a machinist's speed indicator.

When you're not sure how fast your lathe (or other tool) is spinning, you reach for one of these — well, maybe not one of *these*, but a similar tool.

We have three vintage examples, but only one had the manufacturer's name on it. The single close up view is of the counter made by L.S. Starrett Co. in Athol, MA most likely in the 1920s – 40s.

The machinist would set the numbered dial to zero, apply the counter's shaft to the rotating shaft of the machine in question and count the number of times the clock dial rotated within a 6 second time-frame. The manufacturer made it easy by numbering the dial face. The Starrett model would count in either direction.

Each revolution is worth a 100 count, so the number of full revs times 100, plus the count of the last, partial revolution is the total rpm.

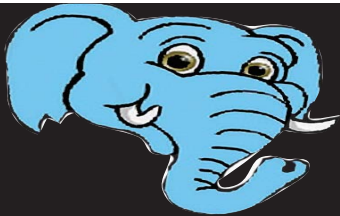

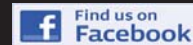
