
("with man's hands").





# Young Pioneer Program at Fort Klock teaches 'hands-on' colonial history

Dressed in period garb, youngsters from around the area learned about Mohawk Valley Indian history, frontier life and colonial lifestyles during the recent Young Pioneer Days held at historic Fort Klock near St. Johnsville.


Eleven-year-old Elizabeth Handy of St. Johnsville was one of the 20 nine to 13-year-olds who participated in the annual event. Handy said that churning butter for lunch was one of her favorite activities at the event, while learning how to load a musket, learning about Indian

culture during a demonstration and lecture put on by re-enactor Glen Bentz, dressing up in costume and meeting new friends, all made the experience a memorable one. Bentz's demonstration and lecture on Indian life in colonial times was a hit with most of the

youngsters. "Let me tell you about my people," Bentz said. He described the growing of "the three sisters", corn, beans and squash and how the pattern of the garden benefited the produce. He explained how bones of different animals were used to make tools, like hoes, and how platforms

were built overlooking the gardens and how children had the responsibility of watching and guarding the crops against crows and other birds and animals. "It

was an important job to keep the crowd out," said Bentz. "The food that was grown all summer long lasted all winter."

He explained about longhouses and how and why they were designed the way they were. "The longest longhouse in New York State was over 200 yards in length."

Bentz also told about how important the role of being a mother was to the tribes and said that the tribes took on the

mother's name, not the father's. Women were highly respected and they were the ones who chose the chief of the tribe. "The women were the ones who watched the children grow. They knew who would make a good chief and they appointed him."

He talked about traditions, legends and treaties, and Indian politics and how the Europeans adopted many of the Indian's values.

Tinker (Alan) Cross, who makes pewter items sold at Fort Klock and other forts and museums, told the youngsters about money used in the colonial days and how folks bartered for things needed. He demonstrated how coins were made and also spoke about how important religion was to people.

"Tinker Cross has been part of this program for a good 15 years," said Dave Klock.

Other re-enactors and leaders who took part in the popular program included Terry and Frank Arduini, Dave and Darla Klock, Skip Barshied, Christine and John Ozinski, Mike, Willow and Griffin McGinnis, Bob Metzger, Tom and Mary Brewster, Lisa Emden, Michael Wren and Bear Claw (Les) Stewart.

Colonial cooking inside and outside, gardening, wheat threshing, colonial games, colonial

school house, black smith work and metal work were all included in the hands-on activities.

"Our young pioneer kids that were previously in the program have been assistants or apprentices this year," remarked Darla Klock. "There was a really good turnout — a great response." Klock said they have a cut off of 20 youngsters and there was a long waiting list for others who wanted to attend.

Alexiss Klock-Oliver, 15, travels from Michigan to be part of the program. She has been attending the Young Pioneer Program for four years and is now a 'group leader' and assistant to the re-enactors. "It's fun!" said Alexiss. "I meet a lot of new people!"

Dave Klock is a direct descendant of the original Klock family. "It's always nice to have young people here to learn about history," Klock said.

## August gardening tips

Keeping a compost pile moist during drought, hastening tomato ripening, and ordering spring bulbs for fall planting are

some of the gardening activities for this month.

With much of our region abnormally dry this summer, or with only light rain showers, compost piles may be quite dry. To remain active, they need to be moist.

Take a hose to the compost pile and moisten the materials to keep them decomposing. Use a compost fork to mix the ingredients, moving the stuff around the outside of the pile into the middle where most of the de-

composition takes place.

Don't rely on nature to provide enough water for trees and shrubs that you've planted this spring or summer. Deep watering once a week will encourage deep roots, which better with-

stand droughts and better anchor trees.

To hasten ripening of already set tomatoes, remove new blossoms as they form. Chances are the new blossoms won't have time to mature before frost, and they will

take energy away from the developing fruit. Don't prune the branches because they are shading and protecting fruits from the hot summer sun.

Late summer is a good time to order spring flowering bulbs, such as tulips and daffodils, from catalogs or online, if you haven't already. The selection is often greater than at local stores, although garden stores usually have plenty in September if you can wait and aren't too particular. Even though catalog orders will be received now, they will be shipped at the appropriate time for planting in fall. Just keep a copy of your order so you know what's coming.

Keep up with harvest of all your produce, giving excess to friends or your local food shelf. In particular, keep squash and zucchini picked while young, or they'll get too large to use. If your pickling cucumbers do get too large, consider making watermelon-type pickles with them instead of the traditional dill pickles.

If you have some bare spots in the garden after peas are finished, beans are harvested or garlic is dug, sow some beets, spinach, and fall lettuce. You can even start snow peas and beans for a modest fall crop. Soak the pea seeds overnight to hasten germination.

As you remove spent plants from your garden beds, if you're not planting a fall crop, sow a cover crop such as winter rye. This will help reduce weed infestation, minimize erosion and compaction from fall rains, and will add nutrients and organic matter to the soil when it is tilled under next spring.

Other gardening activities for this month include keeping hummingbird feeders filled and cleaned regularly, visiting farmers' markets, freezing vegetables for winter, making tomato sauce and pesto and fruit pies to freeze, and visiting — even entering crops you grew — in local fairs.



**Whatchamacallits**

This weeks Whatchamacallit is a handy-dandy tool for a mason or his/her laborer — brick tongs. The design of this tool has not changed much over the years as you can see from the current-use photo on the right.

The set of tongs we have were manufactured by the Donley Brothers Company of Cleveland, Ohio and were used to carry multiple bricks (up to 11 in some cases) at a time on and around a jobsite. Before this invention, laborers used the brick hod – that V-shaped box on a pole the laborers carried. You see them in old photos or Warner Brothers cartoons.

There is no manufacture or patent date on our example, but the company ran as the Donley Bros. Company from 1895 to 1941 when descendants Don and Phil Donley incorporated and changed the name to Ernest F. Donley Sons, Inc.

The following description of the brick tongs

was in the May 1920 edition of Popular Science: "The principle upon which the tongs works is that of a curved lever, the handle when raised serving to clamp against the brick at the lever end of a horizontal bar."

## How to prepare a home for elderly residents

Upon reaching retirement age, new retirees may face decisions regarding their living arrangements. Some seniors may opt to stay put, while others may want to downsize their homes to save money and relieve themselves of the burdens of maintaining larger homes.

But those are not the only situations seniors find themselves in. Some seniors realize they can no longer care for themselves without assistance. In such instances, seniors may opt for assisted living facilities or choose to move in with a relative, such as a grown son or daughter. While assisted living facilities are designed to meet the needs of the elderly, young men and women welcoming seniors into their homes may need to take on some home improvement projects to ensure their homes are as safe as possible for elderly residents.

• Convert a room on the first floor into a bedroom. While this may not apply to all seniors, some men and women struggle with stairs as they age, and that can make it difficult for them to fully participate in a household. Homeowners with an extra room to spare can convert a room on the first floor of their homes into a bedroom so seniors won't have to climb up and down stairs throughout the day. That ease of accessibility to the primary floor of the house encourages seniors to be active participants in a household. If possible, choose an area that is close to a first-floor bathroom.

• Take steps to make bathrooms safer. The National Institute on Aging says that more than one in three seniors over age 65 fall each year, and 80 percent of those falls take place in the bathroom. Slippery tile floors can make it difficult for seniors to navigate bathrooms safely, and bathtubs and shower stalls present additional challenges. Install grab bars on bathroom walls and next to toilets to provide support. In addition, consider installing a shower chair or bench and removable shower nozzle in the shower or tub so seniors can sit down while they bathe and rinse without having to stand up on slippery surfaces. Make sure any mats around bathtubs and sinks are

nonskid to reduce the risk of falls even further.

• Install an extra phone line or two. While kids and adults between the ages of 18 and 50 may never use the landlines in their homes, many seniors still rely on traditional telephones as their primary means of communicating with the outside world. Install extra landlines in your home, including in seniors' bedrooms, so they can more readily access the phone should they fall and need to call for emergency help. Phones in seniors' bedrooms may also provide some additional privacy to seniors who don't want to carry on phone conversations in busy areas of the home, such as the kitchen or living room. Such lines may also re-

duce feelings of isolation.

• Prioritize accessibility when storing items. When storing groceries, books, magazines, or other items seniors are likely to use, choose locations that are accessible to seniors. Avoid storing items on the top shelf of pantries, bookcases or entertainment centers, as seniors with limited mobility may not be able to reach them.

Many seniors move in with their adult children to make their golden years safer and more enjoyable and manageable. Such a change in living arrangements may necessitate some changes on the part of homeowners so they can ensure their homes are safe for seniors.




