



# Lyme disease advisory



Montgomery County Public Health wants to remind everyone that

Lyme disease is caused by the bite of a deer tick. You can reduce the like-

\$125



lihood of a tick bite by taking steps to protect yourself if you live in or visit areas with Lyme disease activity.

In tick infested areas, your best protection is to avoid contact with soil, leaf litter and vegetation. However, if you garden, hike, camp, hunt, work or otherwise spend time in the outdoors, you can still protect yourself:

- Wear light colored clothing with a tight weave to spot ticks easi-
- Wear enclosed shoes, long pants and a long sleeved shirt. Tuck pant legs into socks or boots and shirt into pants;
- Check clothes and any exposed skin frequently for ticks while outdoors;
- Consider using insect repellent (Follow appropriate precautions and product instructions when using these products):
- Stay on cleared, well traveled trails. Walk in the center of trails. Avoid dense woods and bushy areas:
- Avoid sitting directly on the ground or on stone walls;
- Keep long hair tied back, especially when gardening;

 Bathe or shower as soon as possible after going indoors (preferably within two hours) to wash off and more easily find ticks that may be on vou; and

• Do a final, full body tick check at the end of the day (also check children and pets), and remove ticks promptly.

Anyone who has been bitten by a tick should be watched closely for at least 30 days. Typical symptoms of Lyme disease include: fever, headache, fatigue, and a large, expanding skin rash that may have a bull's eye appearance. If left untreated, infection can spread to joints, the heart, and the nervous system. Anyone who develops a fever or a rash after being bitten by a tick or spending time in tick infested areas should seek prompt medical care. Most patients with Lyme disease can be treated successfully with a few weeks of antibiotics, especially if treated early.

Lyme disease prevention begins with recognizing the risks and taking action. For more information on Lyme disease visit www.cdc.gov/Lyme.



# Whatchamacallits



This week's Whatchamacallit is a Betty Lamp, which burned grease, fish oil or animal fats depending on where the owner lived and what was on hand. It is part of a larger family of grease lamps. Betty lamps were designed and largely used during the 18th and 19th centuries.

They were usually attached to a chain with a hook on the end for hanging and sometimes would also have a hooked utensil attached to it (the pickwick) for retrieving the wick from the hot oil, as they would frequently

slide back into the reservoir.

It could be hung from a mantle, wall peg or stuck into a rafter. It was also hung on the rung of a ladder

Its design is not much different from the ancient clay lamps in size and shape and according to my research was the natural progression of this source of lighting

once man perfected the art of metallurgy.

The term "Betty" is derived from the German "besser" — better or in a superior way, and it evolved from the simple spout lamp or "crusie".

It was a "better lamp" due to the addition of the wick holder (shown in the close-up photo), which allowed the drippings from the wick to run back into the reservoir to be burned instead of "wicking" out and over the edge of the lamp.

Wicks were made from pieces of twisted cotton or other fibers.

Some time after that, the lid was added, further improving the lamp by confining heat, decreasing the smoking and making the oil burn more ef-

Both of these changes made the lamps safer by reducing the chance of house fires.


# 9/11 events echo 15 years of remembrance

This is an award presentation recognizing your father's involvement in the history of Fonda Speedway and his continued passion for the sport that nearly took his life. Your father is a perfect representation of the trials and tribulations that the pioneers of our sport went through... But unlike many of the tragedies of the rough and tumble beginnings of our sport, Bill Fake was able to continue on with life, raising a family and becoming a successful self made business man... And as the proverbial frosting on the cake, he is able to be here with us in his 82<sup>nd</sup> year and help us look back on the sport that we all so love."

The owners of the car were Burt Edmunds, Arnold and Henry Flood. The pit crew consisted of Burt, Arnold, Henry and Don Reed.

Bill felt very honored to be presented with this award. "I would like to thank Don Edmunds and the Fonda Speedway Hall of Fame Committee for this prestigious honor and award. I also would like to thank part of my pit crew who were able to be with me her tonight — Henry Flood and Don Reed. I couldn't be happier to be here and be surrounded by my wonderful family, who has traveled from Michigan, North Carolina, Virginia, Massachusetts and all points of New York State. This is truly a night I will never forget," said Fake.

# Bill gives account of his racing career

My racing career started at age 18 on a dirt track in Columbia Center. My passion for this great sport continued at age 19 and 20 racing in Panes Hollow at the dirt track nicknamed "Goodle's dust bowl". I went off to college at Morrisville pursuing my passion for cars and building an engine that was used in my racecar.

It seemed like forever, but I finally reached the age of 21 on May 24, 1955.

This was the required age to race at the "famous" Fonda Speedway — which was my ultimate goal. I applied for my NASCAR driver's license in the first week of June and began my Fonda racing career one week later. I raced there every Saturday night following but was never able to finish due to some mechanical failure or an overheating issue that we were battling. During a Sprint Car race night, I did place first in a consolation race.

My crew and I worked very hard and corrected the overheating issues by September of that same year. The car was running exceptionally well and on Sept. 17, I was driving hard to finish in the top 5 places in order to qualify for the Langhorn Track in Pennsylvania. I qualified in the second heat but had suffered a hit to the right front wheel. I moved into the feature and was again hit in the same place on the seventh lap restart. No one at that time noticed my hub was cracked nor the impact it was about to have. I don't recall much after that restart, as I was driving out of my mind to hold my position in the top 5. All I know is that I was running fourth and holding off the eventual winner of the race, Steve Danish. Danish always took the opportunity in front of the grandstand to pass anyone running strong. On the 17th lap of the 25 lap race, as I rounded the third turn, the hub broke, my right wheel came off, the right suspension dug into the track and flipped my car onto its roof with the rear of the car facing the third turn.

Being upside down, the gas was running through the car as the tank was positioned in the trunk. When Stan Bellinger came around, it was said he was experiencing radiator issues that spewed liquid onto his windshield impairing his vision so he was driving looking out the driver's side window. He never saw my car and drove into the back and right through it with my rear bumper piercing through his windshield.

There must have been sparks as metal met metal and the gas ignited. I was told that Jerry Jerome, who was behind both Stan and me, turned around and came back — to be the first one there with his car's fire extinguisher until Whitbeck and the fire crew got there.

Stan suffered a concussion and flash burn to his face and was in the Amsterdam Hospital approximately 11 days. I remained there for 3 ½ months with nurses around the clock for 10 weeks.

I probably wasn't the most ideal patient as the doctor told my nurses and me that I could have anything I wanted. So it was a daily request of mine to have freshly squeezed orange juice and if someone brought it otherwise, I made them quickly correct that mistake.

The operating room was a familiar place as I was in there at least twice a week for skin grafting or the removal of infected hide. Upon my premature de-

parture from the hospital with the doctor wanting one more skin graft, I went home to my grandmother who painstakingly removed and reapplied bandages every day for the next 6 months until I was fully healed and beyond the risk of infection.

While that was the "not so good" time of racing, I did have fond memories with one being the best friendship I developed at the track.

Willy Chest was a fellow racer and we always pitted side by side. That night of my accident, I had forgotten my driving gloves and he gave me his for the feature race. Even though he's not with us anymore, I never got the chance to say thanks, but I understand he was presented with a trophy for the most last place finishes here at Fonda.

After Bill's acceptance of the award, he presented the museum with his helmet. "As a token of my appreciation, I would like to present the museum with the helmet that I wore that night and during my racing career at Fonda. While my accident shortened my racing career, it also had a silver lining. It is good to know that as a result, safety features have been established such as fire suits and fuel cells which now keep drivers today much safer in a sport that so many of us are passionate about.

Thank you again to the Fonda Speedway Hall of Fame Committee and everyone that is here to share in this honor with me," Fake concluded.
