Presentation recognizes local men who fought in 1812



Historian Lorraine Whiting reports on local men who were drafted from Carlisle and Charleston to fight in the Battle of 1812 at Sackett's Harbor.

The Town Charleston Historian Lorraine Whiting gave an informative lecture on the 1812 Battle of Sacketts Harbor, recognizing three local men who took part in the battle, during a well-attended presentation at the Charleston Historical Society headquarters in the old Baptist Church on Polin Road, on Sept. 18.

Whiting reported on conditions leading up to the war, geographical aspects of the bay and surrounding village, and the ships used in battle.

"The British wanted to take over," Whiting said. "There was a brisk battle back and forth for about two months."

She reported that John Herrick Jr., who was drafted at Carlisle, NY, was among the local men involved in the battle. Herrick was in Capt. Horning's Co. of Militia, serving two months as a private and one month as a waiter to Adjutant Briggs. When taken ill with measles, Herrick was discharged as an invalid from Sacketts Harbor on Nov. 30, 1812, by Gen. Dodge.

Another local man mentioned in the presentation was Robert Dunlap, who was drafted from Charleston on June18, 1812. Dunlap was in Capt. Asa Cady's Co., 11th Militia, 4th Brigade, under Gen.

Dodge and discharged from Sacketts Harbor, December 1812.

A third man, Thomas R. Brand, Corporal, was drafted from Charleston on Aug. 25, 1812. Brand, who may have been friends with Dunlap, also served under Capt. Asa Cady's Co., 11th Regiment NY Militia. Brand was discharged from Sacketts Harbor Dec. 30, 1812.

Whiting reported that her research showed these men received reimbursement at a later date for the clothing and supplies brought to battle with them and claimed. After



Three ways to conserve fuel during your daily commute

Commuting is a part of daily life for many working professionals. According to the U.S. Census Bureau's 2011 American Community Survey, the average American spends 25 minutes commuting to work each day. However, Citi's 2015 ThankYou Premier Commuter Index says the average commute time in the United States is 45 minutes. The reasons for that disparity are unknown, though if one accepts the latter statistic as more accurate than the years-old Census Bureau data, it's fair to say Americans spend far more time getting to work than their neighbors to the north. But commutes in Canada also can be lengthy, as Canada's National Household Survey found that, in 2011,

muters in Canada spent an average of roughly 25 minutes traveling to work each day.

While many people enjoy their daily commutes, feeling it's a time to prepare for the day ahead and, if using public transportation, to relax and let someone else do the work, it's fair to say the majority of commuters would like to spend less time getting to and from work. Many would also like to spend less money getting to and from their offices, and finding ways to conserve fuel is an effective way to do just that.

1. Maintain your ve-

Poorly maintained vehicles endure undue stress that can be prevented by adhering to routine maintenance schedules. Peruse your vehicle's owner's manuals to determine the recommended intervals to change the oil and replace the air filter and spark plugs. These simple maintenance tasks are easy and inexpensive, but they make it easier for engines to run smoothly and make efficient use of fuel.

2. Keep tires properly inflated.

Properly inflated tires reduce drag on the engine. Engine drag makes the vehicle work hard to move, and that wastes fuel. But the type of tires a vehicle has also can affect how efficiently it uses fuel. According to the Transportation Research Board, tires that reduce rolling resistance by 10 percent can improve gas mileage by as much as 2 percent. While that figure might seem insignificant, that percent savings can

add up to a substantial amount of money for commuters who spend 50 minutes every day getting to and from work.

3. Drive a vehicle with stop/start technology.

Stop/start systems, in which engines shut off automatically when drivers brake and restart automatically when the driver lifts his or her foot off the brake pedal, can make more efficient use of fuel. Once exclusive to hybrid cars, stop/start technology is now more widely available and can

cut back on fuel consumption and vehicle emissions. That's especially attractive to ecoconscious commuters who live in big cities where stop-and-start traffic is unavoidable. What's more, many modern air conditioning compressors operate off electricity and not via a car's engine, meaning vehicles with stop/start technology will stay cool in the summer even when the engine shuts

Address windshield damage promptly

Windshields are designed to protect drivers and their vehicles from wind and other natural elements while the cars are in motion.

Windshields are made from tempered glass, which is processed by controlled thermal or chemical treatments to increase its strength compared to normal glass. While relatively

strong for a piece of glass, windshields are not impervious to damage. All it takes is a single rock or piece of road debris to be kicked up from the roadway and hit the windshield to cause a problem.

Every day, motorists encounter pebbles or other small missiles that bounce up from the road and come in contact with

their windshields. Many deflect with no problem, but under high speeds, debris can cause chips, dings, and even cracks in the windshield.

Cracks easily spread from road vibration and heat and can compromise the integrity of the windshield. If your car's windshield is cracked and it shatters during a collision, you and your

passengers are at great risk of injury. In addition, police officers can write tickets if windshields appear to be unsafe. So it's in drivers' best interests to repair

damaged windshields promptly.

Drivers may be able to repair small dings themselves with a do-it-yourself windshield kit available at automotive retail-

ers. If a crack is less than six to 12 inches long, it can probably be repaired as well. However, more significant damage will require that the entire windshield be replaced.

many years, they were able to receive parcels of land and a pension from the government - once they proved they were actually in the battle.

Herrick, who farmed 100 acres and was a blacksmith Charleston Four Corners, received a warrant for 80 acres of land in August 1855. In March 1872, he received a pension of \$8 per month until his death Nov. 03, 1886, when he was believed to be 94 years old.

In 1850, at 58, Dunlap received Bounty Land of 80 acres. At 79, he applied for a pension and

received \$8 per month until his death on Feb. 3,

Brand, who was a farmer and auctioneer at **Charleston Four Corners** during his lifetime, received 80 acres of Boun-

ty Land in March 1851. At 78 years old he applied for a pension, eventually receiving \$8 per month until his death June 4, 1879.

Whatchamacallits



This week, our Whatchamacallit comes the transmission springs just referred to by way of Arriama Mattlock, an acquaintance of our usual supplier, Skip Barshied. It is a Star Tool Co. transmission band compression tool for Ford Model T vehi-

There was no visible patent number on our Whatchamacallit, however there was a patent issued to Robert B. Steuart (US 1540815 A) on June 9, 1925 for Model T transmission band clamps which, except for the handle, looks very similar to our Star Tool item.

The original handle was a single lever type as shown in the patent application diagram. The Star Tool Co. modified it to use the tong-style handle. Perhaps that was more useful in the lifting action during inspection and/or repair.


In his patent application, Mr. Steuart describes the purpose of his invention as an 'efficient tool for compressing and holding

so that the cover may be easily put on. The device is so constructed that it may also serve as a handle for lifting the transmission while inspection, repairs or assembly is being made...".

Apparently, on the Model T, the springs on the clutch shaft, reverse shaft and brake shaft inside the transmission casing,

tended to expand to the point where cover couldn't easily replaced without this useful tool.


