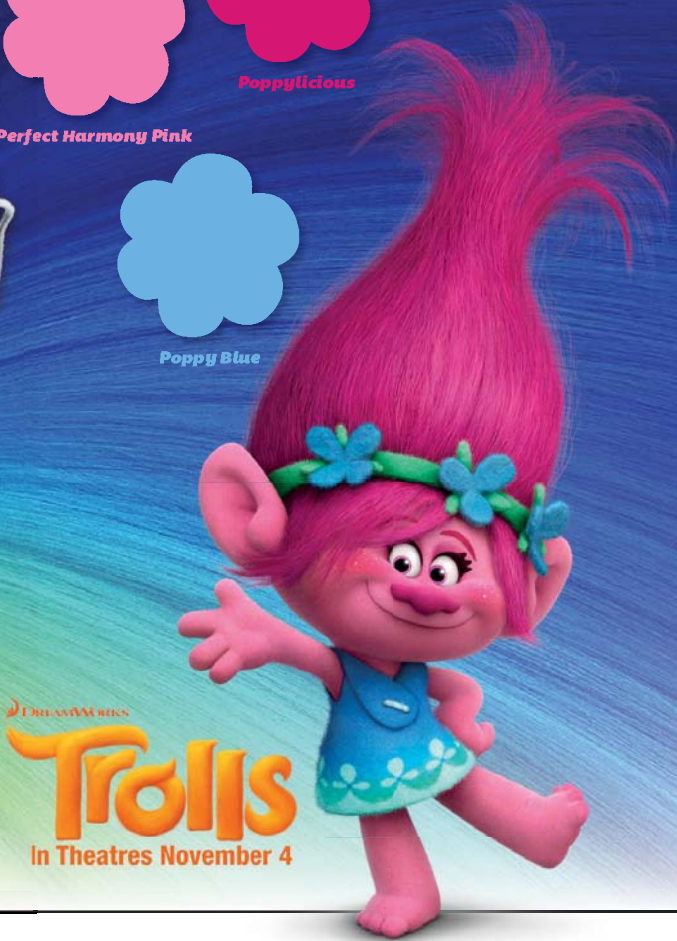
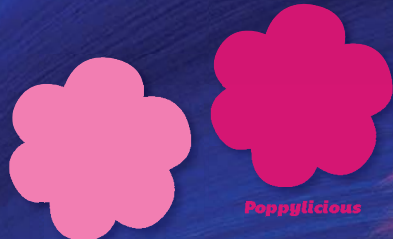

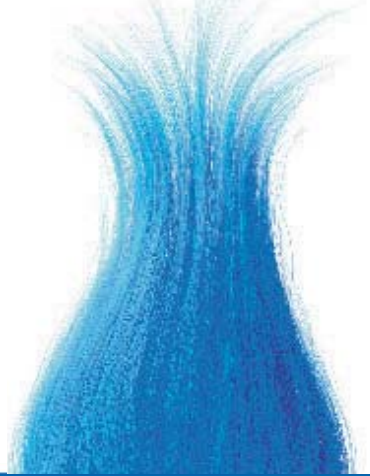

Quilt block sign maker details steps in creation of library's second place vintage quilt raffle prize

FORT PLAIN — What goes into the making of "Quilt Block Square" signage?

Fulton County resident Liz Argotsinger, who has been instrumental in establishing and promoting the tourism related

Fulton Montgomery Quilt Barn Trail, shared with the Fort Plain Free Library a series of photographs chronicling the 12 days of work that went into the 4-foot x 4-foot wooden quilt block signage she created for

the Fort Plain Free Library's vintage quilt raffle.

The second place raffle prize, the quilt block square was constructed of medium density overlay board and layers of paint. Argotsinger ex-

plained, "It's plywood manufactured with a paper face. It's used in signboard. In order for it to be used outside, it needs to be primed really, really good (to seal it from the weather.)" The design is then trans-

ferred to the primed sign board and individual sections are painted.

The decorative display piece was based on the design and colors of the first place vintage quilt that was donated by local history buff, Willis "Skip" Barsheid. The raffle is raising money for the library's ongoing construction project.

Argotsinger noted that 104 quilt block squares have been setup in Fulton and Montgomery counties, and that number is "growing every week."

The Fulton Montgomery Quilt Barn Trail, www.fmquiltbarntail.com, aims to "create a visual trail using unique

quilt barn squares to connect the outdoor landscape throughout Fulton and Montgomery counties."

In the not too distant future, Argotsinger will be conducting a workshop at the Fort Plain Free Library that involves information about the Quilt Barn Trail and the construction and erection of quilt barn squares. She said, "I'm excited to try to get Fort Plain started... By putting up several (quilt barn squares), it will become a tourism trail, and people will take a ride to see it. Once there, they will hopefully stop at

Good Housekeeping: Seafood bake

In this recipe from our sister publication Woman's Day, succulent fish and seafood become a decadent dinner when mixed into a creamy sauce topped with a crispy, shredded potato crust.

- 1 cup low fat sour cream
- 1 tablespoon cornstarch
- 1 tablespoon Dijon mustard
- 2 teaspoons lemon zest
- Kosher salt
- Pepper
- 1-1/2 pounds mixed seafood (such as salmon and shrimp)

- 1 package frozen leaf spinach

- 2 cups frozen shredded hash browns

1. Heat oven to 425 degrees F. In a large bowl, whisk together the sour cream, cornstarch, mustard, lemon zest, and 1/2 teaspoon each salt and pepper.

2. Add the seafood to the sour cream mixture and toss to coat. Squeeze the spinach of excess moisture, roughly chop, then fold into the seafood mixture. Divide among 4 shallow 1 cup baking dishes and place on a rimmed baking sheet.

3. Sprinkle the hash browns over the top and lightly brush with olive oil or coat with cooking spray. Bake until bubbling, 20 to 25 minutes. (For an extra golden brown top, broil for 1 to 2 minutes.)

Tip: To use up the potatoes, make crispy potato fritters: In a medium bowl, combine 4 eggs (beaten), 2 cups frozen shredded hash browns (thawed), 3 scallions (thinly sliced) and 2 ounces ham (sliced into

thin strips). Heat 2 tablespoons olive oil in a large skillet and cook spoonfuls of the mixture until golden brown, 3 minutes per side. Serve with a green salad. Serves 5.

Halloween superstitions revealed

Halloween is steeped in tradition. Halloween season also is a time of year when superstitions take root and add to the spooky and often silly nature of the holiday.

Some Halloween traditions can be traced back to the ancient Celts and their belief that spirits of the deceased were able to wander the earth during the time they called Samhain. Costumes

were worn so the living could blend in with ghosts, and treats were laid out to appease the spirits.

• One Halloween superstition states that if you walk around your home backward three times and then counter-clockwise three times before the sun sets on Halloween, you will ward off nearby evil spirits.

• Legend has it that you will have good luck if you sleep facing south the night before Halloween.

• Apples can help peo-

ple determine if they will live long lives. On Halloween night, you have to make an unbroken apple peel, which will estimate how long you will live. The longer the peel is, the longer you’ll live.

• Another superstition suggests that if you spot a spider on Halloween, the spirit of a deceased loved one is watching over you.

• It is said that no person should lie in a coffin while alive, even for fun. Otherwise, he or she is inviting death. Also, no item of clothing belonging to a living person should ever be put on a corpse when it is placed in a coffin, for as it rots in the grave so will the rightful owner’s health begin to decline.

• Children who are said to have the gift of second sight, which may also include the power to ward off evil spirits.

• People have been warned not to turn around on Halloween night if they hear footsteps behind them, as this could mean Death is following.

• There is a superstition that when you pass a graveyard or house where someone has died, you should turn your pockets inside out to make sure you don’t bring home a ghost in your pocket.

• Jack-o’-lanterns light up Halloween nights. Jack-o’-lanterns were originally made out of hollowed-out turnips, but pumpkins replaced the turnips when the Irish emigrated to North America.

Jack-o’-lanterns were used to guide lost souls and keep evil spirits at bay.

Halloween is full of superstitions, myths and traditions that have been passed down through the years.

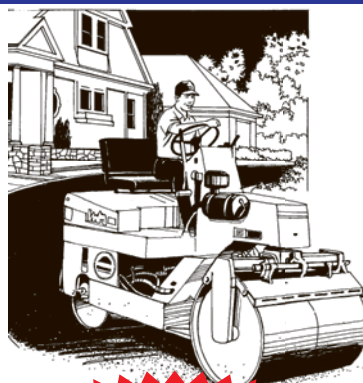

Whatchamacallits



One of my co-workers picked this up a yard sale a couple of weeks ago. She asked the seller if she knew what it was. She said (I'm paraphrasing), "I'm not sure, but there's that Whatchamacallit feature in the Pennysaver, maybe they'll know." She didn't know she worked here – true story.

When our usual friendly Whatchamacallit supplier showed up, we enquired of him and true to form, he didn't hesitate. It's a saw vise. This one is a Wentworth "noiseless saw vise", patented April 8, 1879 (pat. number 214,071) and was invented by William P. Wentworth. Our vise is one of the Number 1 models.

Two manufacturers were listed, Seneca Falls (NY) Manufacturing and Edward E. Stearns & Co. in Syracuse.

According to the ad I found (right), the Wentworth models had flexible rubber cushions (mufflers) between the jaws preventing vibrations rendering the filing action virtually noiseless. You could open and close the vise jaws by rotating the cam lever (circular handle) at the bottom. The Number 1 and 2 vises could easily be attached to a workbench via the holes for bolts or screws.

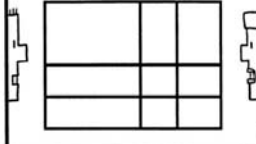

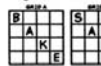
