# Significant tax savings for seniors: what you should know before filing your return

NYS Tax Department and Office for the Aging highlight "subtractions" for senior citizens and retirees filing NYS income tax returns

The New York State Department of Taxation and Finance reminded seniors and retirees that certain "subtraction modifications" may reduce their New York State adjusted gross income, while tax credits they may qualify for decrease the tax due or increase their refund amount.

The modifications relate to certain income included in a taxpayer's federal income tax return that may be subtracted when computing the New York adjusted gross income. The details are provided in the NYS Tax Department's Publication 36, General Information for Senior Citizens and Retired Persons.

"We encourage all seniors to review this publication that's available on our website along with other useful filing information, to help ensure that they don't miss out on valuable deductions and credits," said Acting Commissioner Nonie Manion.

Greg Olsen, Acting Director of the New York State Office for the Aging said, "Many older New Yorkers are on fixed incomes and it's important that they're aware of this publication, which can reduce their tax liability and help stretch their resources. We're pleased to join the Tax Department in getting the word out about Publication 36."

Examples of the subtraction modifications include:

- The pension and annuity income exclusion: New Yorkers 59 1/2 or older for the entire tax year may exclude up to \$20,000 of qualified pension and annuity income from federal adjusted gross income when determining their New York adjusted gross income.
- Married taxpayers who both receive pension income are each entitled to a maximum pension and annuity income exclusion of \$20,000, whether they

file jointly or separately.

• Social Security benefits that are included in federal adjusted gross income are exempt from state and local income taxes and may be subtracted from federal adjusted gross income when computing New York adjusted gross income.

• Qualified pension benefits or distributions received by officers and employees of the United States, New York State, and local governments within New York State, are exempt from New York State, New York City, and Yonkers income taxes regardless of the taxpayer's age.

These are only a few of the many subtraction modifications listed in instructions for Form IT-225, New York State Modifications available at www.tax.ny. gov(search: IT 225).





Parts of a wagon wheel, laid away long ago, just in case they came in handy, survived mostly because the stove pipe on the old box stove had dropped to the floor long ago making the stove useless. Otherwise, these old wood parts would have been burned to keep Grandpa's shop warm. The grass scythe hangs there on e backside of a ceiling beam where it was retired when a later generation got a string trimmer.

Well out of sight hangs an old muzzle loading shotgun along with its powder horn and shot pouch. It was put there long ago, the same as with almost all farms. It has long been silent, but once helped to keep the chickens and other farm animals safe from predators. Long ago the old shotgun could have been taken down by one of the boys of the family and proudly carried to the back woodlot in search of a squirrel or rabbit that Grandma would cook for supper.

We have taken only a very quick tour of the old farm buildings. What have we found? We have found leftovers now called antiques.



There will also be tours of the 1730 Dutch Van Alstyne Homestead.

Original accounts of the August 2 raid began appearing in major newspapers about two weeks after the attack. A newspaper account dated September 9, 1780 stated the following: "At the fort now called fort Rensselaer (Fort Plain), Sir John Johnson and Captain Brant have burnt 51 houses, 42 barns, 17 killed, and 52 prisoners."

The incursion had been more than just a raid however. Research has shown that the Mohawk Valley attacks of 1780 were part of a deliberate British strategy to depopulate the area so that the lands could be retained after the war and thus make the Mohawk the new border between the United States and Canada.

Wayne Lenig is the museum's vice chairman of the Board of Trustees. He has had a 50 year long interest in the interplay of Native Americans, European and African cultures in the Mohawk Valley region. He holds a BA from the University of Buffalo and he is an alumnus of the Cooperstown Graduate Program.

# To your good health: Are dermatologists 'zapping' for dollars?

**Dear Dr. Roach:** I am 73 years old and lived on a boat in my 40s. Now, whenever I go to the dermatologist (two to three times each year), he "zaps" me about 20 times and burns off "cancer cells" or maybe "potential cancer cells." Some of them have been cancer and were healed with MOHS procedure. While I am grateful for the care he gives me, I also sometimes feel that he zaps because each zap means more money. Can you please clarify this for me? — G.B.

**Answer:** I often get questions like this, where a patient has a concern that their doctor is performing unnecessary medical care for the purpose of enriching himself or herself. I always have trouble believing it, since I can't really imagine it, but I recently read about an oncologist pleading guilty to treating with chemotherapy people who didn't really have cancer, which shakes my faith in my profession (and colleagues).

Still, I truly believe that, in your case and probably more than 99 percent of the time, the doctor is being extra cautious to treat you for the sole purpose of reducing

your likelihood of developing an invasive skin cancer later on.

**Dear Dr. Roach:** My mother lives in Florida. Her major discomfort is fatigue and no energy. I have asked her doctor to please give her a vitamin B-12 injection, even though her B-12, thyroid function, vitamin D and blood count are all in the normal range. Her doctor does not believe in B-12 injections. Do you think it might help? — J.L.

**Answer:** Vitamin B-12 is necessary for proper function in many tissues, but it is critical for blood cell production and neurologic function. B-12 deficiency causes an unmistakable anemia (called megaloblastic anemia) and can cause neurologic and psychiatric disturbances even in some people with no anemia. The blood test for B-12 is quite reliable. The major cause of B-12 deficiency is an autoimmune disease that prevents the stomach from making intrinsic factor, which is necessary for efficient absorption of B-12. B-12 can be absorbed orally by people with pernicious anemia by taking very high doses, such as 1 mg. This gives as good a replacement

as injection.

It was common 50 years ago to give B-12 injections as a "tonic." However, it offers no advantages for people with normal B-12 levels beyond the placebo response. As I have noted many times, the placebo response can be very powerful, and 1 mg of B-12 orally is very safe.

**Dear Dr. Roach:** I have heard that drinking water with your meal is bad for you. Is this true? And if so, why? I have a dry mouth due to cancer treatment and must have water with everything I eat. Is something bad going to happen to me? I am otherwise healthy. — R.G.

**Answer:** It's not true at all. Water is, generally speaking, the healthiest drink. It is possible to drink too much water, but it's very hard to do so unless you are taking medications that affect your kidneys or you have excess antidiuretic hormone, an unusual medical condition. Keep drinking your water.

# Whatchamacallits



You probably don't think much about hotel key tags anymore. Major hotels have been using electronic room keys for decades now. I suppose some of the small mom and pop motels may still use the bulky key tag, the purpose of which is to be so obvious and bulky, you don't forget to leave it behind.

Our Whatchamacallit's this week feature a variety of different antique and vintage key tags. The large horseshoe shaped one is 4 x 3.5 inches and bears the name Wilson House (room 36), Oneonta, NY. It is fashioned after patent (No. 460,865) issued in 1891 to E.W. Hall of Whitehall, NY.

According to Mr. Hall's application, the object of his invention was to "provide a novel, ornamental, efficient, and desirable key tag having such characteristics as to permit freedom of movement of the key for the conditions required in manipulating the same and to permit the tag to hang perpendicular when the key is in the door or is hanging in the office, while the liability of the key being lost by the guest inadvertently carrying it away in some pocket is avoided without resorting to a cumbersome or unsightly

construction of tag to effect this result." In other words, he made it too big to be forgotten in your pocket while still being usable and somewhat decorative.

The key tag to the right is from room No. 48 of the Hotel Wagner in Canajoharie, NY, which was built in 1878.



# Spring tips for the fruit garden

by Charlie Nardozzi, Garden Consultant

Pruning, removing mulch from strawber-

ries, and fertilizing blueberries are some of the activities in the fruit garden during spring.

Late winter and early spring is the time to order bare-root fruiting trees and shrubs if you haven't done so already. They will be shipped before they start to grow, in time for planting in your KING'S area. They will need to be planted immediately

upon arrival, so plan your spot now.

Make sure when ordering fruit trees that you get at least two different selections for best cross pollination and fruiting. Some selections are listed as "self-pollinating", and not needing a partner, but fruiting usually is better with a second tree. But choose these self-pollinating ones, when available, if you only have room for one

Also pay attention to the space you have for a tree or trees, and the mature sizes listed. You often can find varieties, particularly of apples, that come in various sizes. This usually is related to what "understock" or "rootstock" the desirable variety "grafted" onto.

As soon as the buds start to swell, it's time to begin pruning apple, plum, and cherry trees. Remove any dead, diseased, or broken branches, as well as crossing and crowded branches, as well as twiggy, nonproductive growth.

Plum trees should be pruned to an open center (no central top stem), while apple and cherry trees grow best pruned to a modified leader in which the center is more closed and tree is more upright (main upright stem was pruned off when planted or prior, and a second upright stem has taken its place). Modified leader pruning results in a bit more open tree, letting more light into the interior, and with stronger stems.

Spray horticultural oil on fruit trees, such as apples, plums, and cherries, to smother any overwintering insects. Choose a calm day when temperatures are above 40 degrees F, and be sure to cover all sides of the branches. You can also apply it to evergreens to control spider mites and other insects.

Carefully follow the instructions on the label for proper usage.

Check strawberry plants twice a week for signs of new growth in early spring. As soon as you see sprouts, remove the hay or straw mulch and spread it in the rows to help control weeds. A topdressing of an inch or two of compost will give plants a boost. If rabbits are plentiful in your yard or neighborhood, you may need to surround your planting with a rabbit fence.

Check apple, cherry, and other fruit trees for nests of tent caterpillars. Blast low-lying nests with water to destroy them, or knock them to the ground and destroy them. A spray of BtK (make sure to get the "K" form of this bacterial spray) will kill emerging caterpillars, but is not toxic to beneficial insects, birds, or humans.

Blueberries benefit from an acidic fertilizer each year. Apply one half pound of ammonium sulfate when the bushes start blooming, and another half-pound four to six weeks later. If the leaves turn yellow with green veins, they may have an iron deficiency. Applying two to three ounces of ferrous sulfate or iron chelate around the base of the plants will help this.

If you have red raspberries and didn't get them pruned after harvest last year, do so now. Keep in mind the summer-bearing varieties produce fruit on oneyear old canes. So prune out those that fruited last year to direct plant energy into the newer canes. You can prune all canes from fall-bearing varieties, as they produce fruits on new canes at the end of the first growing season. Pruning now will direct all their energy into a bountiful fall crop.






