Managing credit when buying a car

Many people in the market for new vehicles intend to lease or finance a car once they find the make and model they want. Such an approach will necessitate a credit check.

Credit checks make some consumers, even those who have relatively good credit, uncomfortable. But when managed well, credit and checks on individuals' credit ratings can go smoothly and save drivers considerable amounts of money over the life of their leases and auto loans.

• Don't leave room for surprises. Even consumers who feel they have firm grasps on their credit scores should check their scores before they go shopping for leases or auto loans. Numerous factors, be it missed payments or high debt-to-credit ratios, can lower credit scores. Even buyers with good jobs and money in the bank may not have good credit scores. When possible, buyers with low credit scores should wait until they can improve their scores before shopping for a lease or loan. The higher buyers' credit scores, the lower their interest rate will likely be, saving them considerable amounts of money over the life of their lease or loan.

• Wait before having your credit run. Some auto dealers may want to run prospective buyers' credit histories the moment those buyers step onto their lots, but it pays for consumers to be patient and wait until they have found a vehicle they like before agreeing to a credit

check. Each time a person applies for credit, his or her credit score dips. But according to Bankrate.com, applicants who file all of their loan applications within one two-week period will only have those applications count as a single credit inquiry.

• Don't overdo it. Buy-

ers with great credit scores may be tempted to stretch their automotive budgets. But drivers who spend more than they can afford may soon find that their excellent credit ratings are suffering. Stay on budget so payments can be made on time and credit scores stay strong.

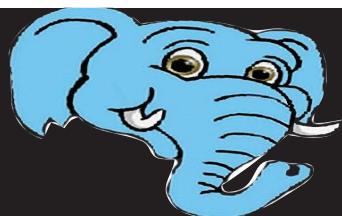

Simple maintenance projects to keep cars running smoothly

One of the ways to keep vehicles running strong for years on end is to adhere to the manufacturer's recommended maintenance schedule. Although there are many factors drivers cannot control, including recalls, weather and road conditions, proper maintenance is something drivers can con-

trol, and maintaining a vehicle can be very simple.

Oil changes

Motor oil lubricates the engine and keeps it in good working order. Old oil becomes more viscous and can lose its efficacy. While changing motor oil is important, motorists should follow the owner's manual or the factory maintenance schedule regarding how often it needs to be changed, as all vehicles are not alike. The old myth that cars and trucks need oil changes at set intervals has changed as digital check capabilities have evolved.

Car computers can now keep track of more than just mileage. Computers now track starts and stops and trip durations to determine when cars need oil changes.

Coolant levels

Coolant helps prevent vehicles from overheating and also prevents the water that it mixes with in the radiator from freezing or boiling. Coolant is nearly as important as motor oil in vehicle maintenance. Coolant is typically comprised of a 50/50 mix of distilled water and antifreeze. These two substances work together to maintain a proper ratio of heat energy and prevent eventual breakdown and destruction of the engine.

Coolant is usually changed once per year or at 30,000 miles. This keeps the coolant work-

ing properly and will help prevent corrosion and deposits from forming inside the cooling system. Coolant levels might be checked during a full-service oil change appointment.

Check battery contacts

Many modern car batteries do not require a lot of maintenance. However, one problem that may occur is a buildup of minerals or corrosion from leaking battery fluid on the contacts. In such instances, use a battery cleaning brush to clean the contacts and then replace the cables.

Tire maintenance

Properly inflated, balanced and rotated tires make for a smooth, safe ride. Check that tires are wearing evenly and that the vehicle is not pulling to one side. A lack of tread on tires requires they be replaced. Because tires can be expensive, many drivers put off routine tire maintenance. But this can be a costly mistake. Tires that are worn or not properly inflated can cause skidding, problems braking and accidents. Blowouts also may occur, putting drivers, their passengers and fellow motorists in danger. It's best to be proactive with regard to tire maintenance.

Maintaining a vehicle in adherence to manufacturer guidelines can prolong the life of the car, improve its safety and increase its trade-in or resale value.

Leonowens about her experiences in the 1860s, when she became a teacher to the children (and subsequently the many wives) of the King of Siam; the movie was a critical and commercial success.

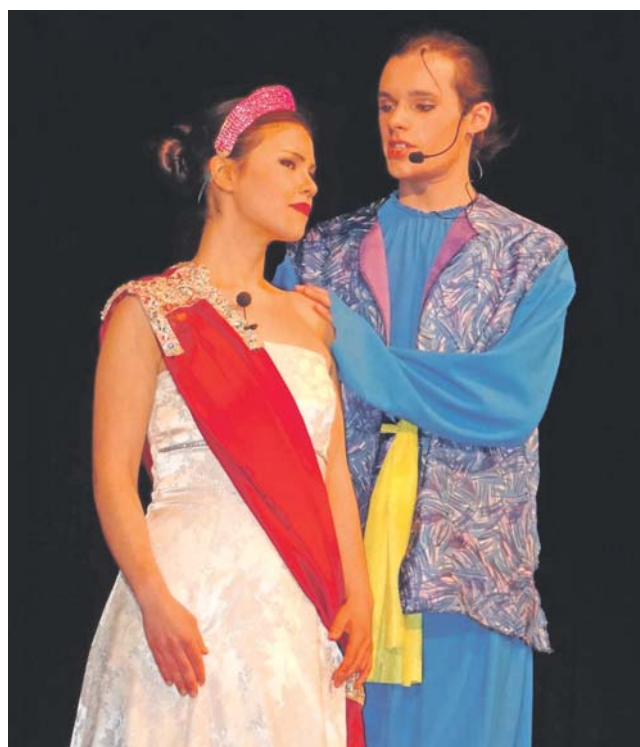
The show was directed by directed by Mr. Will Ryan and Mrs. Lauri Broady.

Whatchamacallits



According to “The Modern Bicycle and Its Accessories (a complete reference book)” dated 1898, our Whatchamacallit was one of several bicycle tire repair kits on the market at that time. It is the Goodrich Jiffy Repair Tool made by the B.F. Goodrich Co., Akron, Ohio. It is nickel plated, 2.5 inches long overall and about a half inch in diameter at the base.

When this Whatchamacallit first arrived here, many in the office (of a particular age group) recognized it as a bicycle tire repair tool — especially the men, as they used it as a kids — sorry PCer’s — that’s just the way it was.

The original version came in a cylinder, also nickel-plated. I’m not certain of the age of our version but it operates on the same principal as the original. The cap on the end encases the needle and the repair compound is pushed out using the threaded plunger at the other end. The cap also has a thin pin attached inside that lines up with the needle’s hole to keep it open.

I’ve copied some of the instructions from the reference book for your reading pleasure:

“The puncture is first located, and the wheel is then turned so as to work from the under side. [The] needle point is inserted in the puncture and the compound is forced through the puncture, which operation leaves a mass resembling a large button over the puncture. The instrument is then withdrawn with a twisting motion ... and after two or three moments of waiting the tire is inflated and if the operation has been a success, the puncture is permanently repaired.”

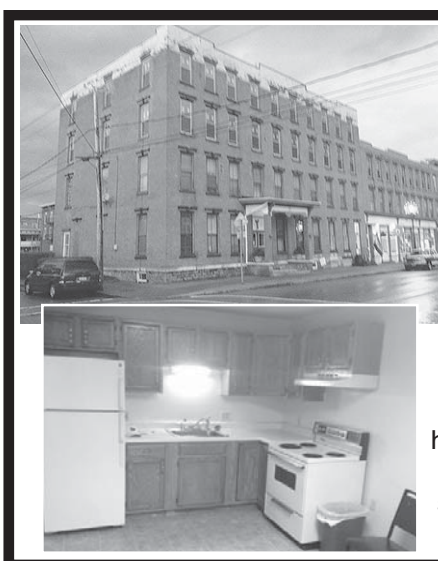

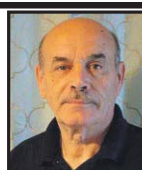
