

When that dish came I closed my eyes and for a moment the empty chair was no longer empty. Ethel, who had made that favorite dish so many times, was there. Surrounding the table were so many Ephratah friends from long ago. The Christmans and Dueslers were there, along with my special friends Curt and Helen Nellis. I know I have forgotten some but please forgive me. Across the room at that big table my family, yet not grown up, were enjoying their meals. I've stepped back many years but my dream must end. My eyes open and I'm again at July 14, 2019. I snap back to the present at a special place



Keep kids safe when mowing the lawn

Warm weather beckons many people outdoors. Perhaps no group of people like being out in the warm sun more than children.

Children should be encouraged to spend time outdoors when the weather allows, as physical activity is one of the hallmarks of a healthy lifestyle. But parents must exercise caution when kids are playing in the yard, especially when the grass is being mowed.

According to the American Academy of Pediatrics, more than 9,000 children in the United States go to the emergency room for lawn mower-related injuries every year. Of the 800 children who are run over by mowers each year, 600 ultimately require amputa-

Many mower-related injuries occur when children who are too young and/or too weak to operate a mower are asked to do so. The AAP recommends that only children age 12 and older operate push mowers, while riding mowers should only be used by kids 16 and older. No child should use a mower without first being taught how to operate it, and kids should always wear eye protection and close-toed shoes when mowing. In addition, parents should never allow children to ride as passengers while moving the lawn.

Mower-related injuries are preventable if parents emphasize safety. The following are some tips, courtesy of the AAP, that parents can follow to ensure their kids do not become one of the thousands of children who suffer mower-related injuries in a given year.


- Only use a mower with a control that stops the mower blade from moving if the handle is let go.
- Keep children out of the yard while mowing. Mower blades can shoot rocks, sticks or other common yard debris out in all directions, and these trajectories put kids at risk of injuries to their eyes and other parts of their bodies.
- Scour the yard for toys before mowing. Toys left in the yard can become trajectories if not removed prior to mowing, and chipped toys with sharp edges can pose a threat to kids even after the grass has been cut.
- Exercise caution if going in reverse. The AAP advises against pulling a mower backward or shifting into reverse unless absolutely necessary. If you must do so, look behind you to make sure no kids are trailing vou or are nearby.
- Only mow when there is adequate daylight.
- Periodically inspect your mower. Periodic inspections of your mower can help you make sure guards, shields, switches and other safety devices are in proper working order.

Whatchamacallits

In the Gazetteer and Business Directory of Montgomery and Fulton Counties 1869-1870, the Young Warrior Mower is described as a "perfectly reliable first class mower."

The originators of the mower, Bramer & Pierce, moved the manufacturing from Fabius, NY, in Onondaga County to Little Falls in January 1869. During the previous fall season, a demonstration of the mower was performed at Little Falls, after which a group of prominent business owners convinced the pair to manufacture the machine there. They raised a significant amount of capital and incorporated the stock company known as the Warrior Mower Company.

"The establishment is on the south side of the river adjoining the tow path of the Erie Canal. The principal building is of brick and stone, 80 feet by 40, four stories high, with an excellent water power."

According to the Gazetteer, the Warrior Mower Company employed 40 men – not counting the furnace men who did the castings – and produced 600 mowers the first year.





Summer time grilling tips

Montgomery County Public Health would like to ensure everyone is grilling safely this summer. A $\,$ few helpful tips include:

- · Always wash your hands and forearms with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds before and after handling food.
- When marinating foods, keep them in the refrigerator. If reusing the sauce that was used to marinate the raw meat or poultry, boil it before applying to cooked food.
- When grilling, preheat the coals for at least 20 - 30 minutes.
- If partially cooking food in the microwave, oven or stove to reduce

grilling time, do it immediately be fore placing the food on the grill.

• True or false: A color change in the juice from the meat from red to gray is a reliable test to assure the meat is safe to eat? FALSE. Always use a food thermometer to confirm the meat is cooked to a safe internal temperature that will kill any existing harmful bacteria. What is a "safe" temperature?

- · Never place cooked food on a plate that previously held raw food.
- Use one cutting board for raw meat, poultry and seafood and another one for fresh fruits and vegetables. If not possible, wash the cutting board thoroughly with soap and hot water between uses.
- · Leftovers can be kept at room temperature for a maximum of two hours or one hour if the temperature is above 90° F.







Now Here's a Tip

- To test the seals on your refrigerator and freezer, close a piece of paper in the door. If you can pull it out easily, it's likely that your seal is loose. Clean or replace door gaskets for a better seal.
- To clean the microwave, try adding the juice of half a lemon to a cup of water and setting to boil (four minutes) in the microwave. Let the steam circulate for an additional four minutes, then remove the cup and wipe down all sides of interior. Use the cut lemon to clean a wooden cutting board. Sprinkle with salt and scrub, then rinse and dry.
- Use a seam ripper, meant for sewing, to remove hair that is wrapped around the beater bar of your vacuum.
- "To keep plywood or thin materials from splitting, I tape my cut line with low-tack masking tape. It keeps my cut sharp, reduces the fraying and it's easy to remove when I'm done." — G.S. in Minnesota
- "Old flowerpots can be brought back to new life with a good scrub, a coat of paint and a healthy dose of sealant. This works especially well on pots with some detailing. The new paint and seal really bring out the decoration, and you can make a group of mishmash pots have a cohesive look." — M.W. in Oregon






