





### AROUND THE DISTRICT .....

- ~Students of the Month: The Jr/Sr High School Students of the Month for December were: Dakota Cohn, Emory Sammons, Jonathan Payack, Beth Doxtater, Alex Bleichner, and Kasey Mang. The Harry Hoag School Students of the Month were: Kelsey Buley, Breeanna Cohn, Andra Fuhs, Brandon Schuyler, Estee Smith, Xavier Tilt, and Loghan VanAlstine. Congratulations to all!
- ~News from the Special Education Department: Fort Plain special education teacher Bob Bleichner and Canajoharie special education teacher Jennifer Schwabrow recently became certified instructors after attending a workshop on non-violent crisis intervention. Both are now certified to teach the special education faculties of each district how to de-escalate a student crisis. The four-day workshop included 32 hours of total training. The training is specifically tailored towards helping the participants to become the best instructors that they can be. Covered topics included: ways to facilitate a group session, methods to enhance adult learning, how to handle difficult questions, managing challenging trainees, and how to best teach the physical intervention techniques through demonstration and practice. Theodore Arndt, Director of Special Education for both the Fort Plain and Canajoharie districts spoke about the success of the training and how Mr. Bleichner and Mrs. Schwabrow will work to help ensure that all faculty are trained to respond and de-escalate student situations before they become a problem. The joint training was a part of the on-going shared services between the two districts. "We wanted to build an inter-district training team." Mr. Arndt said.

### HEALTH & WELLNESS IN OUR SCHOOLS......

- ~District Receives Fitness Center Grant: The Board of Education accepted a \$500 grant from BlueShield of Northeastern New York during its regular meeting on December 11th. The grant will go toward the district's fitness center. The center is open from 5:30-7:30 p.m. on school days. Membership is just \$20/month for all residents. The fitness center features circuit training equipment, free weights, and cardiovascular equipment.
- ~School Lunch Regulations Are Adjusted: The USDA annouced on January 6th that the regulations regarding grains and proteins allowable in school lunches across the nation have been relaxed. The USDA has permanently removed the weekly maximums of grain and protein (meat) units that were previously enacted under the Healthy & Hunger-Free Schools Act. All other aspects of the regulations, including minimum requirements, calorie restrictions, vegetable subgroups, whole grains, daily fruit offerings, fat and saturated fat requirements are all remaining unchanged. In dissolving the maximum allowable grain and protein units, however, school menu planners have been given back more flexibility in selecting the products and sizes that can be served. Citing both this need for flexibility, and increased complaints from school officials about students going hungry after meals, the USDA has issued this permanent rule change with the intent of continuing to enusure that all students have access to nutritious and quality schools meals that are appropriate in size for children of all age groups.
- ~A Better Night's Sleep: BlueShield of Northeastern New York presented a free workshop "A Better Night's Sleep" for all residents on December 19th. Participants left the seminar armed with proven techniques that they can incorporate into their lives, to create revitalizing sleep. Further workshops will be held later this winter.



# To your good health

Shingles rash gone; pain lingers on

Dear Dr. Donohue: Will you please do a column on shingles? I have gone through 12 weeks of the nastiest, worst illness possible. I never hear anything on TV about

Answer: I'll have another go at shingles. Others probably think I overdo it. But it's such a common problem of older people that it deserves repetition.

Shingles is the work of the reawakened chickenpox virus that has been asleep in nerve cells ever since a person was infected, usually in childhood. It's a safe bet to say you were infected even if you don't recall it; more than 95 percent of adults were.

The rash of shingles usually disappears in two to four weeks. Pain, however, can stay with you. The pain is now called postherpetic neuralgia. In making the trip to the skin, the virus damaged the nerve roots that it crawled down to reach the skin. Pain is a consequence of the nerve injury.

A large number of treatments exist for this aftermath of shingles. One is amitriptyline, whose primary use is relief of depression. It also has pain-relieving properties in doses lower than what's given depression. Neurontin (gabapentin) is a seizure-control medicine that often is successful in suppressing pain.

The extended-release form of this drug, called Gralise, is given only once a day. Lyrica (pregabalin) has had a good record in quieting postherpetic neuralgia

Lidocaine skin patches, placed on the skin where pain is felt, are another way to ease pain without taking an oral medicine. Lidocaine is a numbing agent. The latest innovation for shingles treatment is Qutenza, another skin-patch medicine. The doctor has to apply this patch, and lets it stay on the skin for an hour. Then the doctor removes the patch, and the effect of the medicine lasts for three months. It is expensive.

In cases where no treatment brings relief, opioids — pain relievers of the morphine family — have a place in treatment, so long as they are supervised carefully by the doctor.

### Weatherization

Weatherization prevents cold air from entering and heat from leaving a home or apartment. Weatherization's main purpose is to ensure the efficient heating of your home or apartment, resulting in lower heat bills and greater comfort.

Cornell Cooperative Extension offers home audits to qualified low-income homeowners and landlords. The auditor will use the results of the inspection to decide which energy efficient measures will be done on the home. A trained professional will complete the weatherization work.

Weatherization services are free to incomeeligible homeowners. There is a small charge to landlords, if occupants are eligible. Call your local Cooperative Extension office for further information on this program.

The program Weatherization Referral and Packaging Program (WRAP) identifies and refers HEAP-eligible seniors for home weatherization services to help them stay warmer in winter with lower utility and fuel bills. The free program includes an energy audit. The service plan may include replacement or improvement to: insulation, weather stripping, old windows or doors. Eligibility for other programs (e.g., food stamps) will also be determined through this application process.

**Q:** Can I do some furnace maintenance myself? I don't want to pay for a contractor to come every year just to tell me the furnace is fine. — Clive T., Minneapolis

A: While it's important to have a heating professional check your system at the start of fall or winter, you can handle some maintenance tasks in between that will keep your system in good shape reduce the number of expensive repairs you may need later.

First, make sure the air filter is changed monthly during heating season. To improve air intake further, vacuum away dust from the outer cabinet door.

Vacuum the air registers in the house to remove dust and make sure nothing is blocking them, like furniture or dropped items.

Within the unit, clean the blower or fan inside by turning off the heating system completely. Access the fan compartment and clean either the blower or fan blades (depending on your system) with a bottle brush.

Using a vacuum with a hose attachment makes picking up the dust bunnies easier.

Beyond the heating unit, visually inspect the air ducts and make sure they're in good shape, not damaged or loose.

If a duct is loose where two of them meet, reattach snugly using sheet metal screws. Seal the seam with aluminized tape, pressing out air bubbles, so that air flows smoothly through the duct without leaking.
