Office (DRRO) to meet the needs of the survivors of the floods of June 2013

Heavy rains on Thursday, June 27 and Friday, June 28, caused the Mohawk River to overflow its banks and flood the southern end of Herkimer and Montgomery counties. Thousands were without power and over 1,050 households signed up for state aid in Herkimer County alone. In the four municipalities affected there were approximately 44 homes totally destroyed, 75 with major damage and more than 757 with some damage.

In light of its long standing experience in disaster relief and recent work with survivors of Hurricane Irene, Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Albany, through a grant from Catholic Charities USA (CCUSA) implemented the Disaster Response and Recovery Office (DRRO) to meet the needs of the survivors of the floods of June 2013.

The DRRO has become the place where many people in the region have turned to find the support needed to secure services and resources. Utilizing its local Catholic Charities agencies, the DRRO functions as a coordinated, centralized, established location where survivors find help navigating the programs proven to assist in the aftermath of the disaster.

Whether you have applied for the Flood Recovery Program, and even if you were not eligible or were denied assistance — the DRRO case managers will locate resources available to help you. A trained, compassionate case manager will work one-on-one with you to:

- Answer your questions
- Help you develop a plan to address your needs
- Connect with appropriate resources in your community
- See what financial assistance you may still be eligible for
- Connect to volunteer-based Long Term Recovery Groups & Construction Committees

• Advocate on your behalf with service and benefit providers.

The DRRO is connected to county and State agencies, churches, charitable, civic and community based organizations and works to administer and facilitate rapid assistance to the survivors. The DRRO slashes the delivery response time and navigates the client through the maze of social service agencies, long term recovery groups, and other resources identified. This can be a daunting task for a client, who is already overwhelmed by the disaster. Through proven experienced case management techniques, the DRRO's case managers help to resolve unmet needs and guide the client to a successful pre-disaster status.

The DRRO staff is comprised of Wilhelmina Murray-Davis, program director, Brandon Ronca, DRRO case manager for Herkimer and Montgomery County and Theresa Scanlon, DRRO case manager for Herkimer County. The DRRO has offices located in two counties, Herkimer and Montgomery. In Herkimer County, the office is located at the Catholic Charities of Herkimer County, 61 West Street, Ilion, NY 13357. The telephone number is 315-894-9917 ext. 240. Fax Number 315-894-6313. In Montgomery the office is located at the Fulton-Montgomery Catholic Charities, Kimball Street, Amsterdam, NY 12010. Cold weather management for animals

The winter of 2013-2014 is shaping up to go on record as one of the harshest in decades and all domestic creatures exposed to its rigors need help in making adjustments to survive the elements.

Winter is no less a problem for pets than it is for their larger companions out in the barnyard and for some maybe even more so.

One of the more dramatic situations encountered during the winter months is that involving the outside cat who finds warmth on the engine block of a car and curls up for a nap. The the owner then appears, gets into the vehicle, starts it up and the startled cat jumps into the fan or becomes entangled in fan belt. Remember when there is any likelihood of this scenario playing out in your garage to bang on the hood or blow the horn before starting the car, a precaution too easily forgotten.

Most state and town roads are liberally salted during snow and ice storms and dogs in particular find the taste of salted particularly snow appealing which. when consumed in any quantity, can be toxic. Today the cocktails being applied to roads contain even more potentially lethal combinations that must be avoided at all costs. It is the owner's

duty and responsibility to keep your animal away from such materials. When bringing a dog in from an airing in areas where ice melters have been used wipe the paws or wash the paws in water to insure that when the paws are licked such material is not ingested. Ice and snow build up between the toes is another reason for wiping the feet after a walk in the snow, it is an irritant, may cause abrasions and lacerations and contribute frostbite. Some breeds of dogs have been specifically bred to withstand the rigors of arctic-like winters but most have not so that reality must be dealt with.


With winter comes a spike in the incidence of house or barn fires due to the increase in the use space heaters. Use of these heaters must be continually monitored to insure

that they are not compromised in any way. Not only may tipping result in fires but animals rubbing against them may result in severe burns. Along many other potential winter hazards, carbon monoxide detectors must be checked regularly to insure that they are in proper working order, CO2 can be as lethal to animals as it can to humans.

Extra precautions should be taken to insure that elderly pets or pets whose health is compromised are handled in such a way as to avoid making existing problems worse by subjecting them to frigid conditions. Animals suffering from arthritconditions much more likely to show the effects of frigid conditions. Other common conditions that may be adversely affected by cold weather include diabetes, heart disease, kidney disease, and diseases such as Cushings.

Some animals because of size, temperament, preference or other factors may have to live outside during the winter. In these instances insure that the ration boosted to increase the caloric intake and that there is an good supply of fresh unfrozen water available at all times. Electrically heated water bowls are available. It is interesting to note that water in plastic bowls does not freeze as readily as it does in ones made of stainless steel.

Winters are not always easy but they are manageable if animal owners prepare for it in a systematic way and are willing to take the extra time required to insure that the few simple steps suggested are followed.



Whatchamacallits

Soapstone (also known as steatite) is a type of metamorphic rock. Soapstone is often used as an insulator for electrical components, due to its durability and electrical characteristics and because it can be pressed into complex shapes before firing.


The use of this particular piece of soapstone is unclear, but it is thought to be a foot warmer, often used when out on a buggy ride (similar to a hot water bottle.) The handle would have been for carrying the stone after it was heated, when it would be too hot to touch.

Today, soapstone is used for inlaid designs, sculpture, coasters, and kitchen countertops and sinks. The Inuit sometimes use soapstone for traditional carvings. Certain Native American tribes make bowls, cooking slabs, and other objects from soapstone.
