

D. H. Robbins Elementary School ~ Jumping for Hearts

Celebrating the American Heart Association's 35th anniversary of 'Jump Rope For Heart' was a huge event for the students at D.H. Robbins Elementary School in St. Johnsville.

The children there have collected over \$2,700 in donations, with more pledges still coming in.

On Monday, Feb. 24, the Jump Rope Team, led by Coach Hillary Cool, put on a performance to remember and finalists from each grade took part in play-off competitions.

"I originally was introduced to the event when I was a teacher at Mayfield," said Cool. "When I was hired last year at St. Johnsville and realized they ran the program, too, I was excited to keep the program going!"

Cool said new activities were added to the program this year and more new events will be added each year to keep the program exciting.

The event is especially exciting for this year's new principal, Becky Marzeski, who has pledged to jump rope once for each dollar raised! This feat will be performed with the students watching and cheering her on.

"Students counted today while I jumped 700 times," said Marzeski. "I will be jumping the remaining number of times to match the dollar amount raised by our students during this week, and by Friday, I will have accomplished my promise to D.H. Robbins students!"

Cool believes it is important to teach children how to give to others and that this was a great opportunity to accomplish that.

"I am really proud of all the students at DHR," said Cool. "What these children have done for others is very encouraging to see. It leaves you with a feeling of hope."

Coach Cool says rope jumping is great exercise for the children — and working to build strong hearts and other muscles is what physi-



Dear Editor:

I have read with interest but not surprise of the proposal set forth by some of our new county legislators that would adversely affect our county historian archivist. For over 65 years, I have watched the Montgomery County Department of History and Archives and those who staffed it. All too often the history of our area has held a back seat, often purely because of politics.

It might be well if we remember that what went before us is much the same as the foundation of a structure. Without that foundation, the building is found to be weaker. The department has sometimes come close to being dissolved — something which would have been tragic to those whose ancestry comes back to this historic area. I have known well those who were county historians. All too often, as the winds of politics changed, so did those who held that position. Unfortunately many of us who were involved in historic preservation sat back and said very little or nothing.

I cannot say that any of the past appointees were bad people, but I believe I can say that some did not belong in that position. I do hope that our present historian, Kelly Yacobucci Farquhar, and the staff and volunteers are encouraged and allowed to retain their positions. They have done a superb job and I am sure will continue to do so if they receive the consideration they so justly deserve from the new legislation.

GOULDS PUMPS

Modern ice chippers have prongs that are straight instead of curved, more resembling mini pitchforks. Many are just single pronged, like sharp letter openers.

Since 2006, several communities across North America have implemented laws to prevent smoking in cars when children are present, and campaigns for smoke-free car laws are poised to continue.

The public has become increasingly aware that there is no safe level of exposure to secondhand smoke. Secondhand smoke, also known as environmental tobacco smoke, includes the smoke that a smoker exhales and the smoke that comes from burning tobacco products. Thousands of toxic chemicals are present in secondhand smoke, including formaldehyde, lead, butane, cyanide, and carmonoxide. These bon

dangerous chemicals can be inhaled and tend to linger in the air for hours or longer. Smoke residue also clings to a smoker's body and hair and can even surface inside of a home or vehicle, according to The Mayo Clinic.

Asthma, heart disease and cancer may result from contact with secondhand smoke. When someone smokes within the small enclosed space of a car, passengers are exposed to air that is many times more toxic than what the EPA considers hazardous air quality, even if a window is down. What's more, the particulates of tobacco smoke that are absorbed in the upholstery

off-gas back into the air even after many days have passed, exposing riders to toxins well beyond when someone smoked in the car.

The developing bodies of children and their small stature put youngsters at risk for greater complications from cigarette smoke, although any passenger is at risk.

Laws vary depending on location and typically apply to children ages 16 and under. Smokers are urged to quit smoking for their health and the health of others. But those who continue to smoke should refrain from smoking when inside a vehicle, especially when children are present.
