



Whatchamacallits

Before machines, farmers used a variety of hand tools when sharpening their scythe blades.

At right is the more commonly-known whetstone. We still use whetstones to sharpen knives and other blades today by quickly running the edge of the knife along the grain of the whetstone.

The middle item is a denglesteck, an anvil-type item which was hammered into the ground. The farmer rested the dull scythe blade on the protruding end of the denglesteck and used a small hammer to tap the dull blade into a sharp edge.

At left, you have items similar to a hammer and chisel, which would be used

for more delicate engraving or sharpening.

Indoor plant tips and activities for April

Start seeds of warm-season plants, including tomatoes, peppers, eggplant, marigolds, zinnias and petunias, indoors for transplanting later to the garden.

Apply fertilizer to houseplants according to label directions as days grow brighter and longer and new growth begins. Foliage plants require relatively high nitrogen fertilizer, while blooming plants

thrive on formulations that are higher in phosphorus.

Keep Easter lily in a bright, cool location, out of direct sunlight. Water as soil begins to dry. The yellow pollen - bearing anthers inside the flower can be removed by pinching to prevent staining of the petals.

April tips for the yard - lawns, woody ornamentals and fruits

Plant a tree in celebration of National Arbor Day, April 25. Bare-root stock should be planted before new top growth begins. Balled-and-burlapped and containerized stock can still be planted later in spring.

Fertilize woody plants before new growth begins. Two pounds of actual nitrogen per 1,000 square feet should be sufficient.

Complete pruning

chores, removing dead and injured branches first.

Apply a prebloom, multipurpose orchard spray to fruit trees.

Remove winter coverings from roses, but keep mulch nearby for protection from late freezes. Prune and fertilize as needed.

Apply pre-emergent herbicide to control crabgrass in lawns.

Smelly fireplace?

After a long season of use, fireplaces need to be cleaned. Many think homeowners this is a job that can be put off until the fall, but spring is an ideal season to have the chimney and flue cleaned and inspected.

One reason to include scrubbing the chimney as part of spring cleaning is to cut down on odor. After using a fire-place, a buildup of creosote forms in the chimney. As the weather gets warmer,

creosote deposits can start to smell sour and that odor will seep into the home. In addition, moisture can mix with the creosote and start to degrade the flue liner, necessitating costly repairs.

The sooner a chimney and flue are cleaned the better. A chimney sweep can do a thorough job of scrubbing down the chimney and fireplace and ensuring that everything will be in working order come next season.

by Samantha Mazzotta Drafty windows a costly nuisance

Q: Our front room windows have never been very good at keeping out drafts on windy nights, and in the summer, it's the hottest room in the house. Do we need to replace these windows? — Charlene T., via email

A: Drafty, leaky windows have a number of causes for — from warped or old frames to single-pane windows and more — but completely replacing windows and the frames can be quite costly.

Your electric company may offer an energy audit kit — or can even send a professional to perform an energy audit — at low or no cost. A basic kit can determine that hot or cool air is escaping the house, while more detailed audits can determine where that air escaping.

Another way is to simply bring in a window replacement contractor to inspect the front-room windows, determine what's wrong and present an estimate for the cost of repair or replacement. This is the costliest option, so be certain the problem is severe enough to warrant window and/or frame replacement. Consider getting two or three estimates from differcontractors compare prices.

In the long term, investing new. in higher-quality windows can save a lot in heating and air conditioning costs, and help make the front room comfortable year-round.

In the short term, you'll want to take inexpensive measures to prevent drafts and, in the summer, cool air from

escaping.

If you've performed an energy audit or have been able to figure out just where outside air is blowing through, you can lessen the problem. Air entering under the sash can be blocked by placing a length of foam weatherstripping along the underside, where the sash meets the frame. Thinner weatherstripping can be installed vertically along the frame to prevent drafts from entering between the window and frame.

Install double-paneled curtains on all the windows of the room. In the winter, these provide an extra buffer between drafts and you. In the summer, these solid curtains can be pulled shut when the sun is shining into the room, to help keep the room cool.

These short-term measures can save some energy, but to really make that room comfortable, take a serious look at replacing the windows, particularly if they're old or the frame or sash are visibly warped.

HOME TIP: Take a tour of your home and make note of as many improvement or maintenance tasks that you can find. Then create a schedule to tackle a few of them at a time.

Vaseline glass

Q: I have three glass bowls from the 1950s. A dealer in my area has identified them as being pieces of Vaseline glass. What is Vaseline glass, and is it collectible? — Emma, Conway, AR

A: Vaseline glass is a transparent yellowish-green or greenish-yellow glass, so named because it is close to the color of Vaseline petroleum jelly. When first made, it was marked as canary glass. Early Vaseline glass gets its color from uranium oxide when added to lead glass. The result is a glass that will flash two colors in sunlight and fluoresce under ultraviolet light. Other yellow-green glass will not. Your second question is easier to answer. Yes, it is collectible, and prices depend on the piece and

where it is being sold.

Q: My dad was a carpenter and had quite a tool collection. I am in the process of liquidating his estate. and it has now come down to his tool room. Can you advise me? — Billy, Rio Rancho, NM

Step 2: Review your credit inventory



### Running on empty: How far can you really go?

(BPT) — Whether intentional or purely circumstantial, it's likely that most experienced drivers have seen the low-fuel light illuminate their vehicle's dashboard at least once. For some drivers, the fuel light is a source of anxiety as they search for the closest gas station. For others, it can be a bragging right, proudly boasting how far they push their gas tanks to the limit.

It's no secret that an automobile can continue to run after the fuel light comes on, but should drivers rely on the extra mileage it allows?

It's likely most drivers would agree that the fuel light often comes on at inopportune times. Stuck in traffic on a freeway; running late for an important appointment; or driving on a country road with no towns or gas stations in sight, is when drivers decide to push the fuel gauge past the "E" signal.

Some popular car models can make it between 30 and 50 miles after the fuel light goes on, according to a study by Pick Analysis. The average Chevrolet Silvera-

do will continue for about 33 miles beyond empty. Smaller cars like the Volkswagen Jetta average about 43 miles and the Toyota Corolla tops the list at 47 miles.

Knowing how far a vehicle can drive with low fuel may be reassuring, but the effects of low-fuel driving can be damaging to the car.

"When you're running low on gas, it's best not to push your luck," says Neil Hoff, a refined fuels specialist with CHS, which supplies more than 1,400 Cenex branded gas stations. "Stopping to fill up before your gas gauge hits "E" could save you stress, damage to your car and time spent on the side of the road."


Hoff explains that by allowing a car to run on empty, dirt and contaminants are more likely to become suspended in the fuel and block the fuel filter. When fuel is extremely low, the fuel pump is no longer suspended in fuel and can overheat. In some cases, low fuel can even affect power steering and brakes.

To avoid an expensive trip to a mechanic, Hoff

advises taking a proactive approach to fueling, advising drivers to always keep at least a quarter tank of gas in the tank at all times. Running out of gas in heavy traffic is not only inconvenient but also dangerous, so Hoff recommends fueling up before getting on highways or major roads. Also, becoming familiar with where gas stations are

along a driving route will also help prevent running out of gas on long trips. Always keep a gas can in the trunk in case of emergencies.

"Keeping your car fueled is cheaper and safer, in the long run, than driving on empty," Hoff says. For more helpful automotive information and gas-saving tips, visit www.tanksofthanks.com.
