So whates a cresset?



The user would fill the basket portion with burning wood " often pine knots " and then mount the device over the side of their boat or at a selected place on shore, over the water. The light shining down into the water attracted fish to the area so they could be more easily caught. That means

more fish on the table, and a light to work by!

€ Seek recommendations from trusted friends and family members. Talk to friends and family members whose insight you value about which wedding vendors they used. If you attend a wedding or another party and find the flowers or the

music particularly well done, ask for the name of the florist or band. Wordof-mouth advertisement is a great way to find quality wedding vendors who will help make vour dream wedding a reality.

€ Consult with a wedding planner. If budget allows, work with a wedding planner. He or she will have an extensive list

ding planners have already vetted and verified certain vendors as quality workers.

€ Always ask for references and donet ignore them. Busy wedding vendors should provide you with a list of names of satisfied customers. Talk with couples who used the vendors services in the past and ask the

of wedding vendors you can contact. A wedding planner wants the job to get done right and efficiently, and many wed-

questions that are most important to your decision-making process. Unbiased feedback also may be available through online review sites, but direct contact with references may make you feel more comfortable. If a vendor fails to provide references, this should raise suspicions about the persones reliability.

€ Deposits should be a fraction of the total price. Avoid wedding vendors who insist on hefty deposits. A deposit is a goodfaith agreement to hold the date of the wedding, and it should be a small percentage of the overall cost of the services.

€ Do not pay balances too far in advance. Man y wedding vendors require the balance be paid on the day of the wedding or shortly before. Good vendors realize couples will not want to pay the tally until they have received the products or services they signed up for. A photographer may ask for the final payment when albums are delivered. The exception may be a caterer or reception site that needs the funds to order food and beverages a few weeks in advance. Paving off a vendor too early means you run the risk of that vendor having your money and then not coming through on the wedding day. It's difficult to track down a person for a refund, plus youere left with finding a replacement at the last minute.

€ Contracts are your friends. Every agreement should be in writing. You have a better chance of ge. fighting for a refund or restitution in court when you have a contract in writing.

€ Consider wedding insurance. Even the bestlaid plans can go awry on a wedding day. Anythin g from freak weather events to illness to vendor absences can wreak havoc. The Better Business es. Bureau advises purchasing wedding insurance to protect yourself when weddings are especiall y costly. Such insurance may cover vendors who fail to show up, cancellations, inclement weather, military deployment, medical emergencies, and RIE ravel delays. With wedrs. ding insurance, you won•t money if change. A basic insurance policy that covers loss of photos, videos, attire, presents, rings, and deposits usually costs between \$155 and \$550, depending on the amount of coverage you want.

(BPT) " Aggressive drivers speed, drive too fast or carelessly, change lanes without warning, cut off other vehicles, tailgate and pass in ways that endanger others. Aggressive driving likely causes •a substantial

highways, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) says. Everyone is aware of aggressive drivers, but you may be surprised to learn how many people think that other drivers are the only offenders; " aggressive drivers may be closer than they appear

Eighty-five percent of motorists describe other drivers• behind-the-wheel behavior as aggressive, yet only 36 percent admit their own driving is agcrepancy, the survey also revealed wide-spread agreement on two important points: 82 percent said they experience negative feelings because of how other people drive, and 72 percent said they welcome chance to improve the driving experience for everyone and make at least one change to their own behavior. The survey also identified behaviors that, if stopped, would make

The survey also identified behaviors that, if stopped, would make driving more pleasant for everyone. This includes cutting off other drivers (59 percent), using high beams toward oncoming traffic (57 percent) and tailgating (56 percent).

•People•s emotions and anxieties often will play out on our roads and highways, putting us all in tense, high-stress driving conditions that can be dangerous, Ž says Jonathan Alpert, a Manhattan-based psychotherapist and author of the book •Be Fearless: Change Your Life in 28 Days.Ž Alpert has also

written about road rage.

•Changing aggressive driving habits is not only good for society, but it•s good for your mental health. Simple positive acts can have a huge impact on how you feel by activating the reward center in the brain "meaning it really can make you feel good.Ž

Alpert offers some tips to help drivers begin curbing aggressive road behaviors:

€ Aggressive drivers cut off other motorists, tailgate, have unnecessary and excessive use the horn, speed and change lanes rapidly. If these behaviors describe your driving habits, resolve to make a change for the better.

€ Model good driving behavior by being friendly and courteous on the road. Your good behavior can inspire others to be courteous as well. Give up a parking spot, and when it•s safe to do so, allow other drivers to move into your lane.

€ Accept that some un-

desirable road conditions, such as heavy traffic, slow drivers or excessively fast ones are a normal and unavoidable reality of driving. If you normalize these irritations, youere less likely to be frustrated by them.

€ Don•t take it personally. A driver who cut you off was likely just being thoughtless, and didn•t intend to anger or endanger you. Consider other explanations; perhaps the driver is traveling to an emergency or simply didn•t see you.

In addition to improving your own behaviors and encouraging others to do so, too, avoid antagonizing aggressive drivers. NHTSA recommends you do your best to get out of the way of aggressive drivers and donet encourage them by speeding up or attempting to block them. Avoid eye contact and ignore rude gestures "in short, don•t encourage bad driving behavior by behaving badly yourself.
