New York State Public Health Law requires that all dogs, cats and domestic ferrets shall have initial vaccinations administered against rabies no later than 4 months of age and stay up to date with re-vaccinations. Revaccinations are required one year later and a booster shot every three years. It is important to have pets vaccinated in a timely manner in order for the pet to be considered protected

against the virus. Pet owners should bring proof of their pet's last rabies vaccination. This helps the veterinarian determine whether the pet will receive a one or three year vaccination; without it your pet will receive a one-year vaccination only. Veterinarian administration fee is \$10 per rabies vaccine. To assure the safety of other pets and people; dogs must be leashed; cats and ferrets must be contained in a pet carrier or box when attending the rabies clinic.

#### Safety will make you a happy camper

(MS) — Ah, nature. Besides the mosquitoes, nothing says summer like a getaway to the great outdoors.

As you wind down from the stress of packing up and driving to the cottage or campsite, the CSA Group, a leader in testing and certification, wants to remind you to stay safe on land and water this summer with these tips.

#### **Boats and cottages**

- Always wear a personal flotation device and never consume alcohol while operating any vehicle.
- Make sure that certified carbon monoxide (CO) and smoke alarms are properly installed outside all sleeping areas.
- When opening your cottage for the season, carefully inspect all appliances and electrical cords for damage from rodents or insects.
- Ensure boats and cottages are equipped with proper emergency safety equipment, including first aid kits and fire extinguishers.

CO and Smoke Alarms

- Carbon monoxide is a silent killer. To prevent CO poisoning, fuel-burning equipment should only be used in well-ventilated areas.
- Test each unit at least once a month because the threat doesn't take a vacation.
- Change the batteries at least twice a year. A good routine is to change them at the same time you reset your clocks for Daylight Saving Time.
  - Be sure to use the correct type of batteries.
- Follow the manufacturer's detailed operating in-

#### Camping stoves and lanterns

- Fuel-burning equipment such as stoves, lanterns and cookers should only be lit outdoors and at least nine feet from tents, combustible materials and vehicles.
- Before use, carefully inspect parts for leaks, blockages or damage.

- Keep flammable clothing (and eyebrows) away from open flames, and carefully monitor children and pets around fuel burning devices.
  - Before packing up equipment, make sure it is com-

pletely turned off and cool to the touch.

# Seniors willing to discuss driving abilities, yet conversations rarely happen

baby boomers beginning to reach 70 years of age, the number of seniors on the road will rise steadily over the next two decades.

A new survey released by Liberty Mutual Insurance finds that the majority of senior drivers are behind the wheel regularly, even with reported limited physical abilities. Though many seniors drive safely well into their later years, it's likely that they will eventually have to face the difficult decision to stop driving. While the majority of senior drivers surveyed are open to conversations about limiting or stopping their driving, only 6 percent have spoken with someone about their driving abilities.

The report reveals that despite declining physical abilities, many seniors still drive several times a week or even every day. In the past six months, the majority surveyed reported driving regularly despite slow reaction times, difficulty seeing or hear-

ing, getting lost or feeling confused while driving.

While nearly all senior drivers would consider limiting or stopping their driving if presented with the right reason, most are hesitant about transitioning to the passenger seat. Top concerns among seniors about limiting or stopping driving include losing independence, becoming less active, difficulty finding alternative forms of transportation, and feeling isolated.

In 2013, Liberty Mutual Insurance conducted a survey of children of elderly drivers to determine if they were having conversations about driving with their aging parents, and if not, what was preventing them. The survey found that more than half of children with senior parents were concerned about their parents' driving abilities and safety, yet nearly one-third avoided initiating the conversation. However, this new report reveals that people may be avoiding conversations with aging drivers more than self-reported, while more seniors are actually open to talking:

- Only 6 percent of senior drivers report having had a discussion about their driving abilities, despite 84 percent saying that they would be open to talking about the issue.
- The majority of seniors who have not yet had a conversation report they would feel most comfortable being approached by their children or doctor.
- Seniors cite a doctor's recommendation and recognition of their own declining physical abili-

ties as top reasons to limit or stop driving.


